



2026-2027 Book Process

Here you will find step by step instructions for purchasing books and materials for the 2026-2027 school year.

1. Review Your Course List

- Your Course List will be emailed on July 14.
- This list shows the courses you will take during the 2026-2027 school year.

2. Review the Book List

- The Grade 9-12 Book List will be published on July 15 on the New Student Information page.
- The Book List is organized by subject and course.
- It includes required textbooks, materials, ISBN numbers, and purchasing information.

3. Purchase Materials

- Families may purchase materials through Amazon, Barnes & Noble, or other vendors unless otherwise noted.
- Please make sure to purchase the correct edition using the listed ISBN number.
- Some courses may include direct purchase links on the Book List.

Optional: NHS Book Rental Program

The National Honor Society runs a book rental program.

- Students in Grades 9-12 or their parents will be able to rent books in person on **July 25, August 1, or August 29.**
- A list of books available for rent will be released in late June.
- **Rentals are \$15 per book** (cash or check).
- Rentals are first come, first serve.

Required Fees

1. Fontbonne Planner

- All students are required to have a Fontbonne Academic Planner.
- The **\$15 Fontbonne planner fee** will be added to your FACTS account the week of July 14.

2. Chromebook Insurance

- All students are required to purchase Chromebook Insurance for their school-issued Chromebook.
- The **\$40 Chromebook Insurance fee** will be added to your FACTS account the week of July 14.
