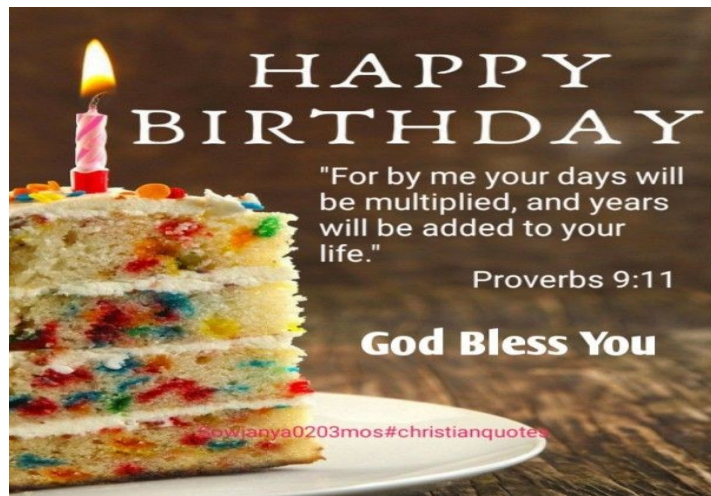

Greetings to God's Children as we live in the glory of Christ Jesus. It is again with the greatest pleasure that I am privileged to write this note to you. In beginning of this note I would like to reference a piece of scripture and ask you where we are standing in accordance with the Scripture. God's Word, "Two men will be in the field; one will be taken and the other left. Two women will be grinding with a hand mill; one will be taken and the other left. Therefore, keep watch, because you do not know on what day your Lord will come... So, you also must be ready, because the Son of Man will come at an hour when you do not expect him.""

When I read this Scripture, it causes me to pause, and wonder am I ready or have I become to complacent to really know how to get ready for the coming of my Lord. When we read the examples Jesus gives, they seem to be doing the same things and very much alike. So, what is different between each of them? I know that it is not ourselves that will be judging us and that it is Christ, so how do we have the ability to understand how we are to get ready for Christ's coming. I believe that it would be imperative for us to begin at the very beginning, in God's Word. First, we probably begin by looking at the scripture about our history and see where our forefathers are leading us and how they were or not ready for Christ. But let us not rely only on the past, because we must live in the present and look forward to our future. Spend MORE time reading of God's Holy Word MORE intently to learn even MORE than we now know. Spend MORE time in prayer with our Lord, asking MORE of our Lord than what we are now asking, expect MORE from our Lord than we are now expecting.

Have you caught the key word that I believe is very important in our preparation to be ready as our Lord has brought to our spirit? I already know that many are already giving the Lord a lot of our time and energy, but I wonder if it is ever enough time? I would ask us what is our time worth but our very own eternity. It would appear to me that Christ is absolutely worth all the time we have and it is incumbent upon each of us to give it freely just as our Lord gives us His Love and Grace so FREELY. How about if we take stock of where our time is currently being spent and see how important these things are and decide if they are more important than our salvation. I have no doubt that if we look closely, we will find Christ is always of MORE importance. Enjoy the summer!!

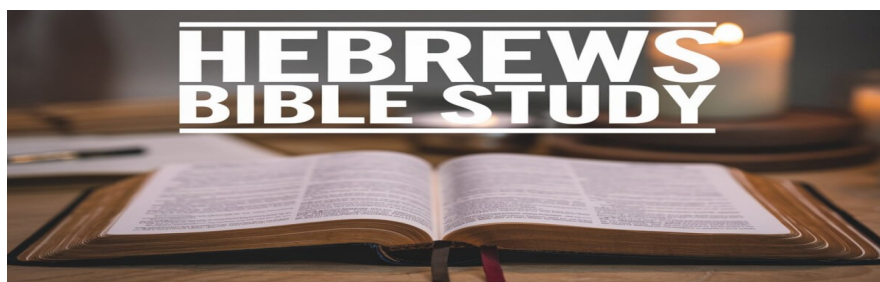
