From the Chaplain's Desk



Over the last few days, I have been thinking about the Fruits of the Spirit, maybe it's because of all the beautiful fruit I see around me in the month of August. Here in the Niagara region, every summer I wait in anticipation for those Niagara peaches, which I am now enjoying.

In a Christian's life fruit is the direct result of whatever controls our hearts. If God controls our hearts Galatians 5:22-23 tells us, "... the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control."

It is important to remember that fruit grows, therefore so does the Fruit of the Spirit, as we grow in maturity and faith in God.

This month I want us to think about the fruit of LOVE. The English word love has very broad meaning, but the Greek language was very precise. The love mentioned in this scripture is agape. This love is not a feeling, but a choice. It is the choice to be kind, to sacrifice, to consider another's needs greater than one's own. Agape is used in other Bible verses in the New Testament:

"Greater LOVE has no one than this, that one lay down his life for his friends" (John 15:13).

"LOVE your enemies, do good to them..."
(Luke 6:35).

"For this is the LOVE of God, that we keep His commandments: and His commandments are not burdensome" (1 John 5:3).

Love is the greatest gift God has given us and loving others is the greatest gift we can give to God.

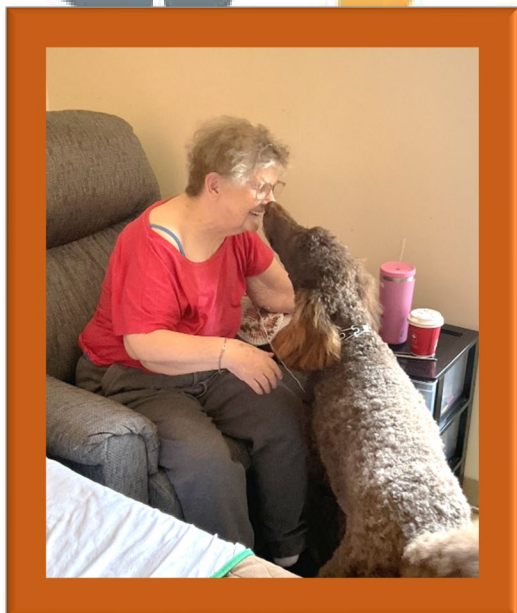
My prayer is that just as the fruit has ripened during this season, so to may our LOVE mature and show the fruits of loving one another.

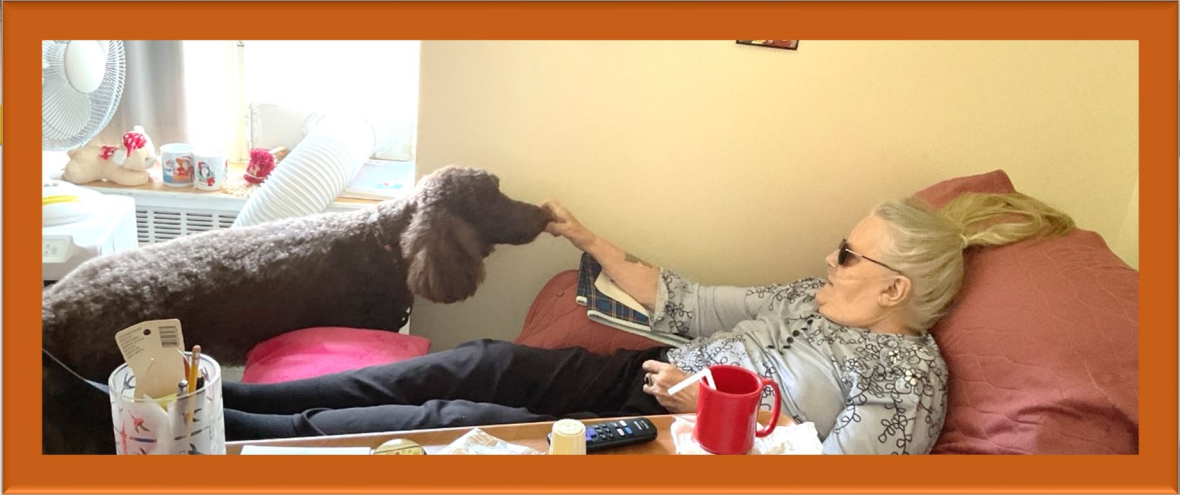
