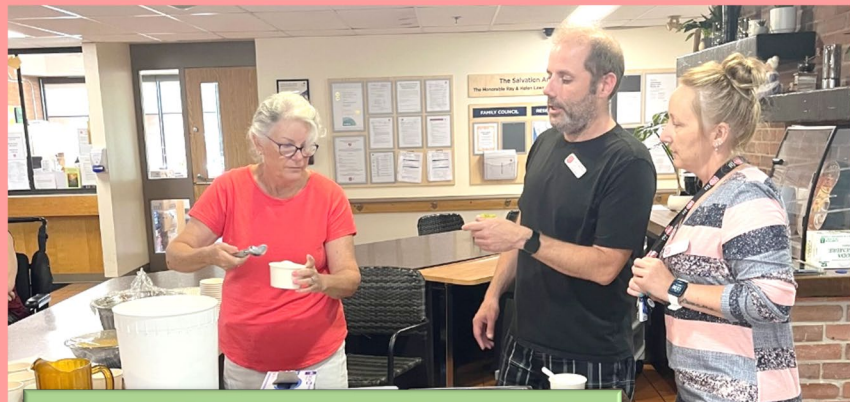


Hand Washing

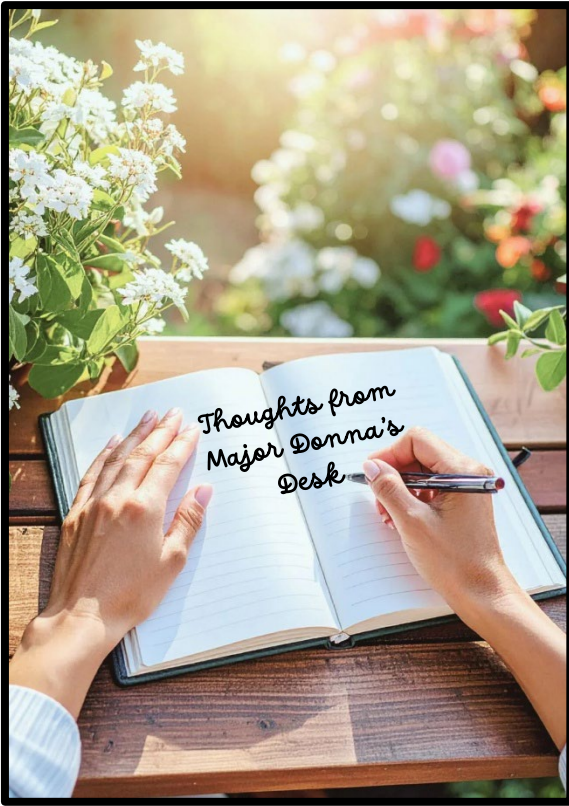

Let's thank God for the many things He's already blessed us with, instead of asking Him for all the things we don't have. I'm going to enjoy the warmth of summer.





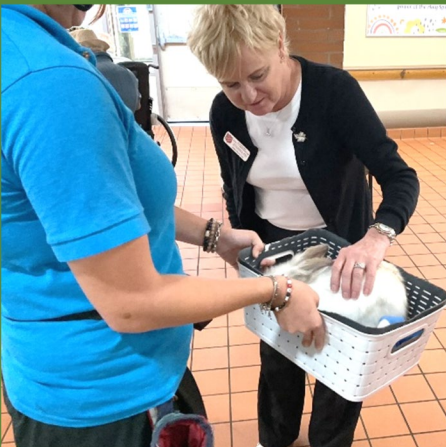

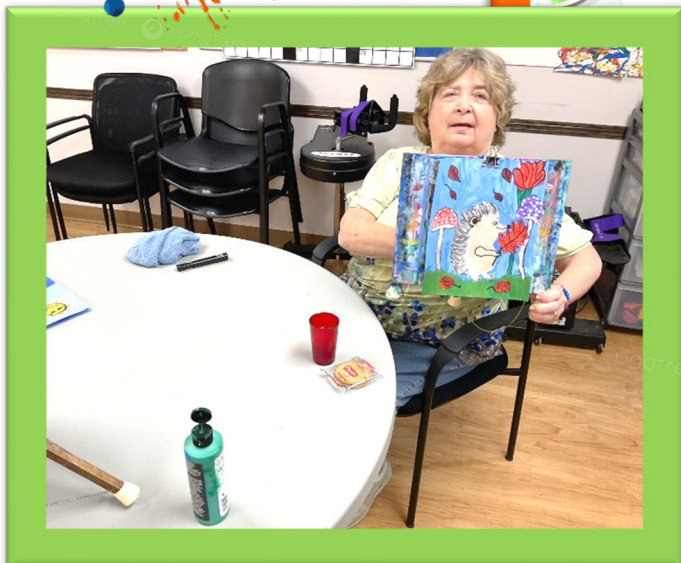




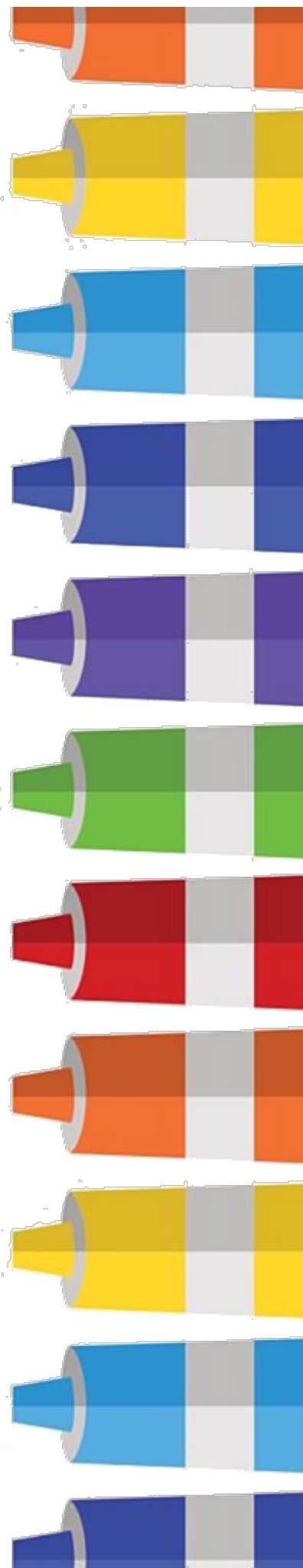
