I love the nativity story because it's filled with ordinary moments. Ordinary people, doing ordinary things.

And then God moves.

The day Jesus was born was just an ordinary day, but then something miraculous happened.

The real nativity story is about how,

"God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. (John 3:16) It's the story that connects real life moments with the good news of Jesus Christ.

Luke 2:4-7, So Joseph also went up from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to Judea, to Bethlehem the town of David, because he belonged to the house and line of David. He went there to register with Mary, who was pledged to be married to him and was expecting a child. While they were there, the time came for the baby to be born, and she gave birth to her firstborn, a son. She wrapped him in cloths and placed him in a manger, because there was no guest room available for them.

I wonder how many people walked beside Mary not realizing God in human form was a mere few feet from them, inside the belly of a woman. How many people were kind to Mary during those uncomfortable travel days, not realizing they were helping tend to the mother of the Savior of the world?

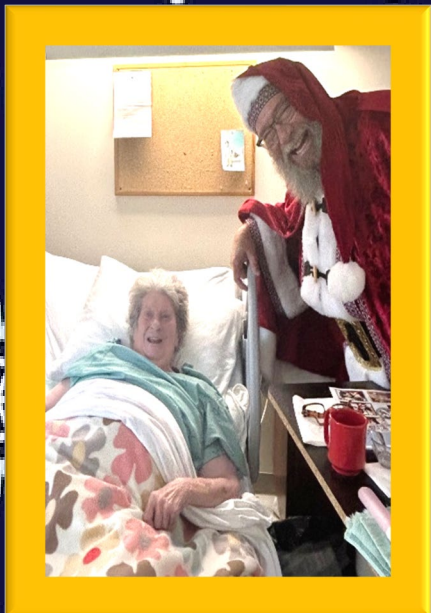

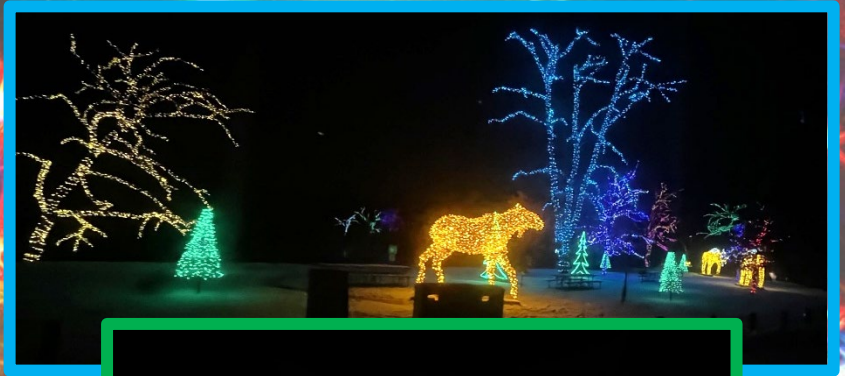
