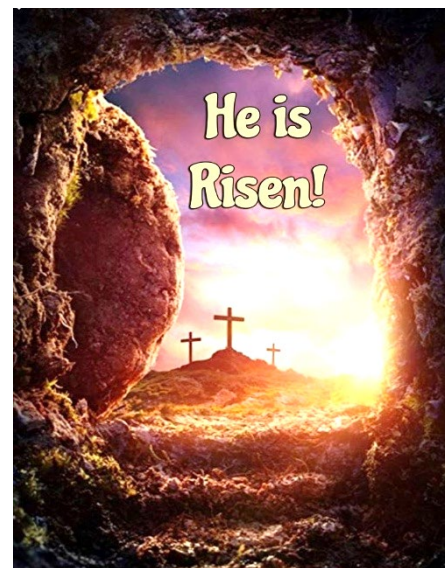
I don't want Easter to come up and surprise me. I want to prepare my heart for the beautiful gift of the cross and then be able to celebrate with joy the power of the resurrection.

and lead me in the way everlasting."* (Psalm 139:23–24)

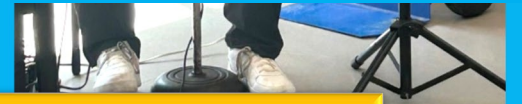
Preparing our hearts before Easter is not about earning God's favor. It's about remembering the truth of the gospel and reflecting on Christ's death and resurrection on our behalf.

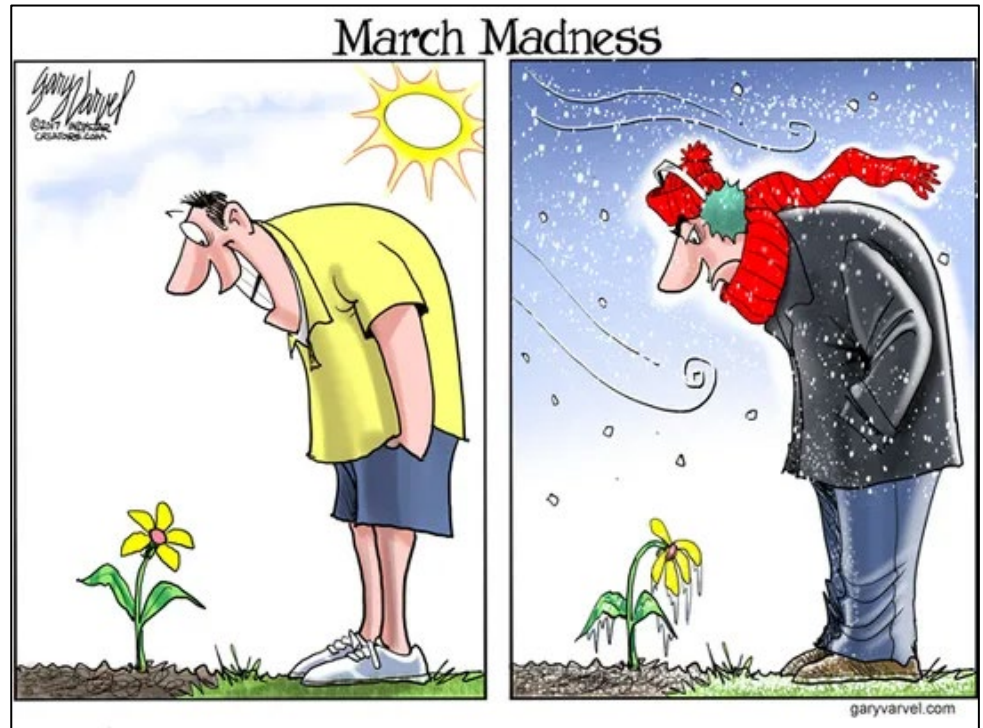
The Salvation Army Canada and Bermuda has four core values:
