Growth can often feel slow both in my garden and in my life. Paul reminds us that perseverance matters because God's timing is wise. The unseen work beneath the surface is still real.

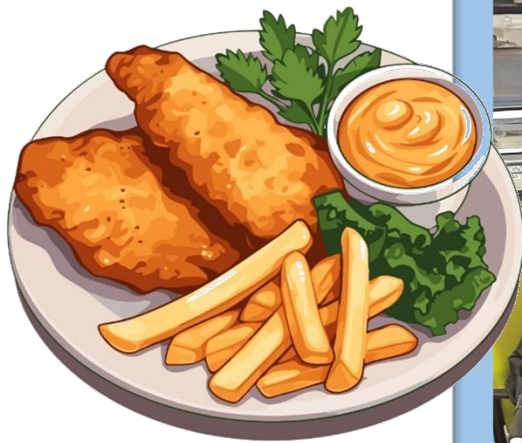
The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning. Lamentations 3:22-23
