

From the Pastor's desk....

I pray you had a good Christmas; that you were able to encounter the Christ Child who gives healing and peace in a special way. We now open up Ordinary Time for a short while until Ash Wednesday. Our liturgical color for Ordinary Time (meaning there is "order" in our sacred readings) is green—a color of new life and growth in Jesus Christ.

Food Pantry Donations at Work

Christmas wound down with another reason for hope for the families we serve at the pantry. They received holiday gift cards from Target and Walmart of well over \$6,700. In addition they received holiday hams with their holiday sides.

For the year we were able to provide just under \$67,000 in assistance to 2,983 families which included over 10,445 individuals. We continue our partnership with Northern IL Food Bank and their member stores. The value of the food donated through our partnership with the Food Bank is estimated at \$232,000.

Included below is a breakdown of some outflows:

- ◆ \$4,800 in client rental/utility expenses
- ◆ \$54,800 in Aldi gift cards to assist provided food products we aren't able to provide.
- ◆ \$8,242 in miscellaneous operating expenses, supplies, etc.

None of this is possible without the generosity of our parishioners at Christ the King. Hopefully this enlightens you as to what your donations are providing throughout the year. This has been a rough year for all; especially so for those we serve at the pantry.

We at the pantry are overwhelmed by the your generosity.
