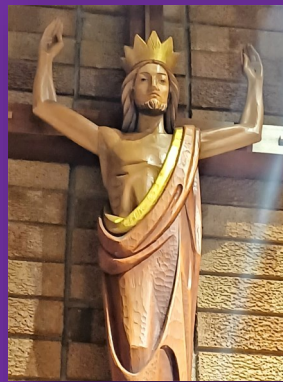

From the Pastor's desk....

New carpeting is coming to our church! You may have seen carpet samples up near the sanctuary. With different input, there are 3 final colors. We will have a display set up for you to look at, and then "vote" on what color you would like. Once the carpet is chosen, we will work logistically with our carpet people and the crew that will remove/replace the pews. A big project that takes place about every 25 years.

We hope to start this 4-5 week project some time in May. We have a window of opportunity during the summer time. When this project starts, all masses will take place in the gymnasium. Our altar and ambo will be moved into the gym, along with some other things to make that space our temporary church. Funerals will have the option to be celebrated here or at Ascension, St. James or Sacred Heart.

The pews will be removed and stored in the Parish Life Center and the Narthex. Obviously, the church, narthex and parish hall will not be available. Classroom space in our Faith Formation Center will be available for some gatherings. Because of your generosity, this is a cash project.

As this project moves along and we have dates and a timeline, we will let you know. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we move towards this large and seldom project.

Fasting consists of eating only one meal, with the possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add up to a single full meal.

Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain from meat on all Fridays in Lent.
