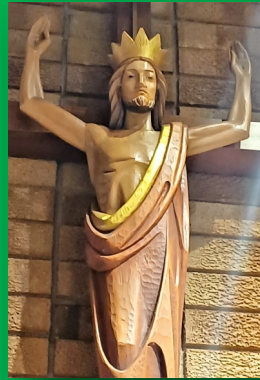

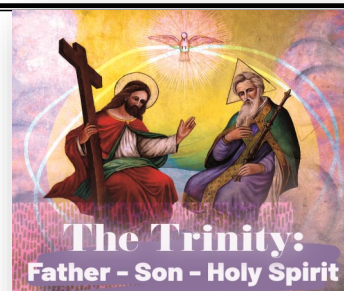
From the Pastor's desk....

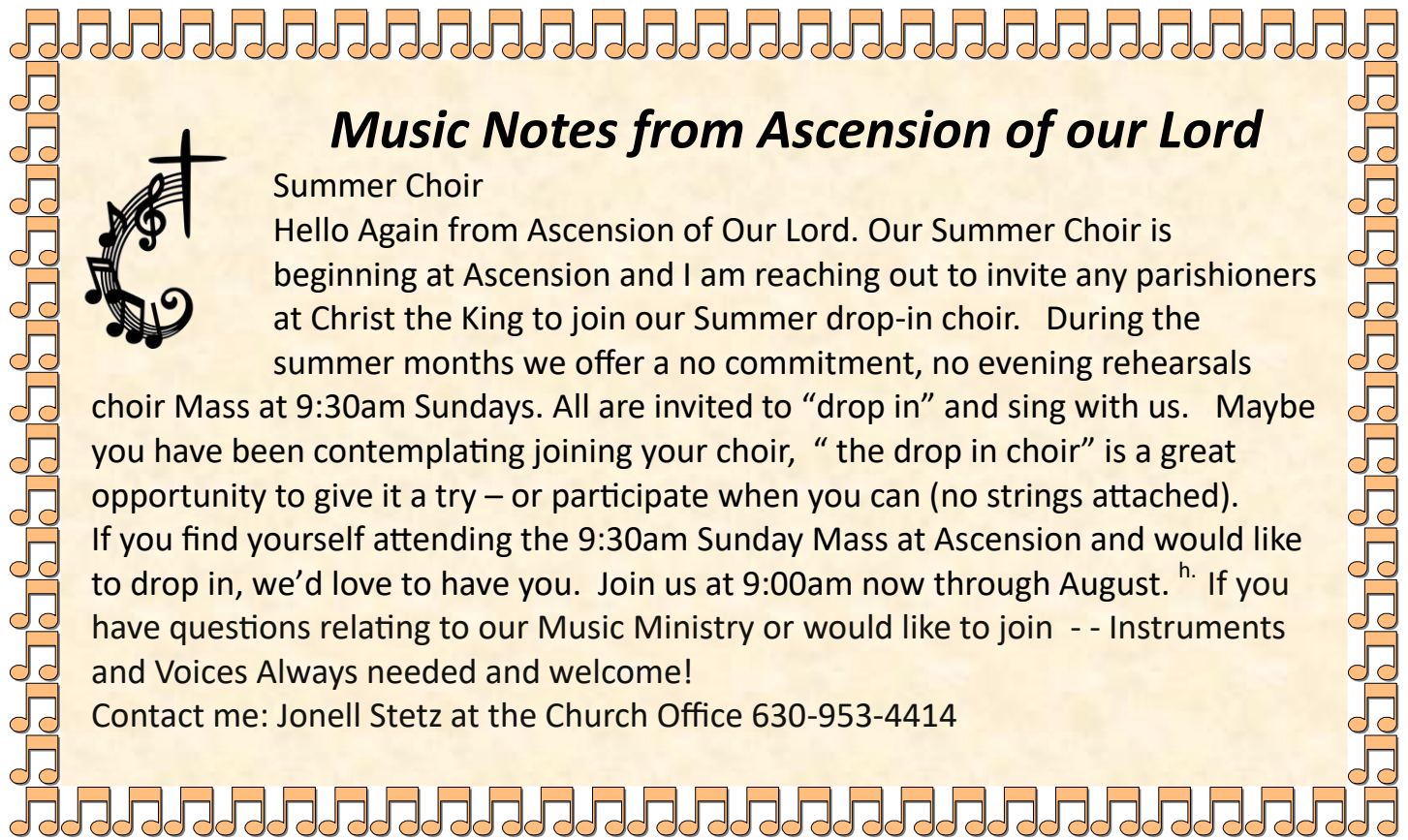


Now would **you** be interested in showing off your nationality cooking skills and tempting our taste buds!

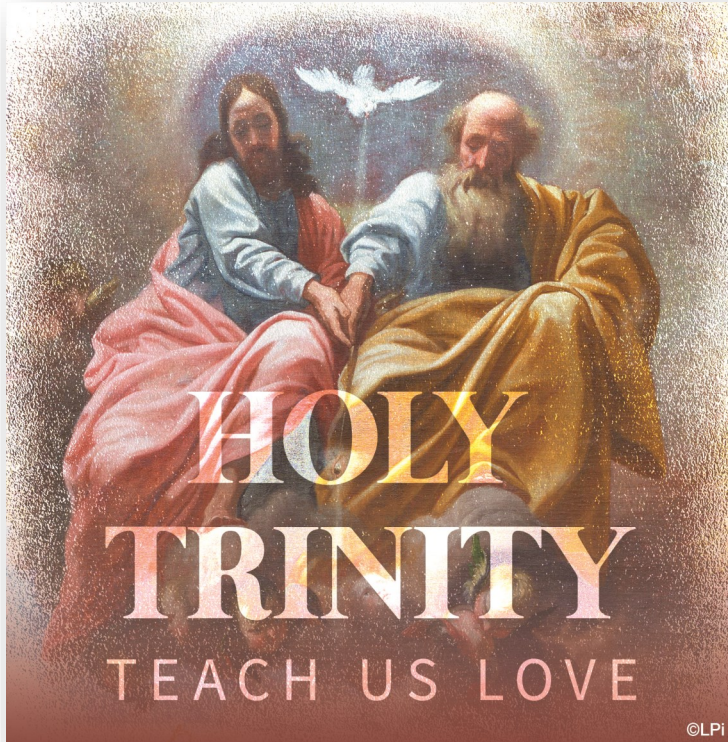
Saint Vincent DePaul Society Food Pantry Items Request
