After a series of events, it was decided that Ascension in Oakbrook Terrace and Christ the King in Lombard would be merged to form one new parish—new name, one bulletin, one pastor, etc. However, an Appeal has been taken to the Vatican to reverse the decision. Until this Appeal is settled, and all issues come to a close, we are maintaining to a degree, 2 separate parishes. I will, however, be the only assigned priest for the 2 locations. Starting next Sunday, the Sunday morning mass times will be different at each location. Sunday morning at Christ the King, Lombard—8:00 & 11:00. Sunday morning at Ascension, Oakbrook Terrace—9:30.

You will see me and Fr. Bob Schoenstene on the weekends at both locations, with the help of one of our retired priests at both locations from time to time.

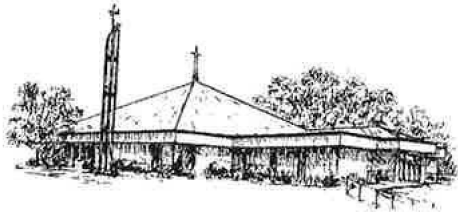

Dear Parishioners of Christ the King and Ascension of Our Lord,

As we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, I am pleased to share with you the Holy Spirit's guidance regarding the Mass schedule for both parishes beginning July 1. After much prayer, and consultation with parish transition team members, I have discerned the following schedule starting Tuesday, July 1, 2025:

Weekday Masses:

- 8:30am Monday through Friday at Christ the King
- Noon Monday through Friday at Ascension

Weekend Masses:

- Saturday at 4pm at Christ the King
- Saturday at 4pm at Ascension
- Sunday at 8am and 11am at Christ the King
- Sunday at 9:30am at Ascension of Our Lord

Through the generosity of retired priests this schedule is possible, maintaining weekday, Saturday Vigil, and Sunday Mass times at both Christ the King and Ascension, even though I will be the only priest formally assigned to both parishes. It will be a time of adjustment, as each location's current Mass times for Sunday are going to be different, but with change comes opportunities for growth and new possibilities. I encourage parishioners from both communities to try a Mass at the other location. For example, if the 8am is too early for some members of Christ the King, feel free to join Ascension for the 9:30am Mass. Or, if a member of Ascension would like an earlier start to their Sunday, please join the 8am Mass at Christ the King. As I mentioned in my last letter, we are all part of "one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all," – Eph. 4:5-6 (NABRE) invited to the Eucharistic table together.

I look forward to this new chapter, as the shepherd of both communities. May the Holy Spirit continue to guide us as we venture forward on a shared mission of faith.

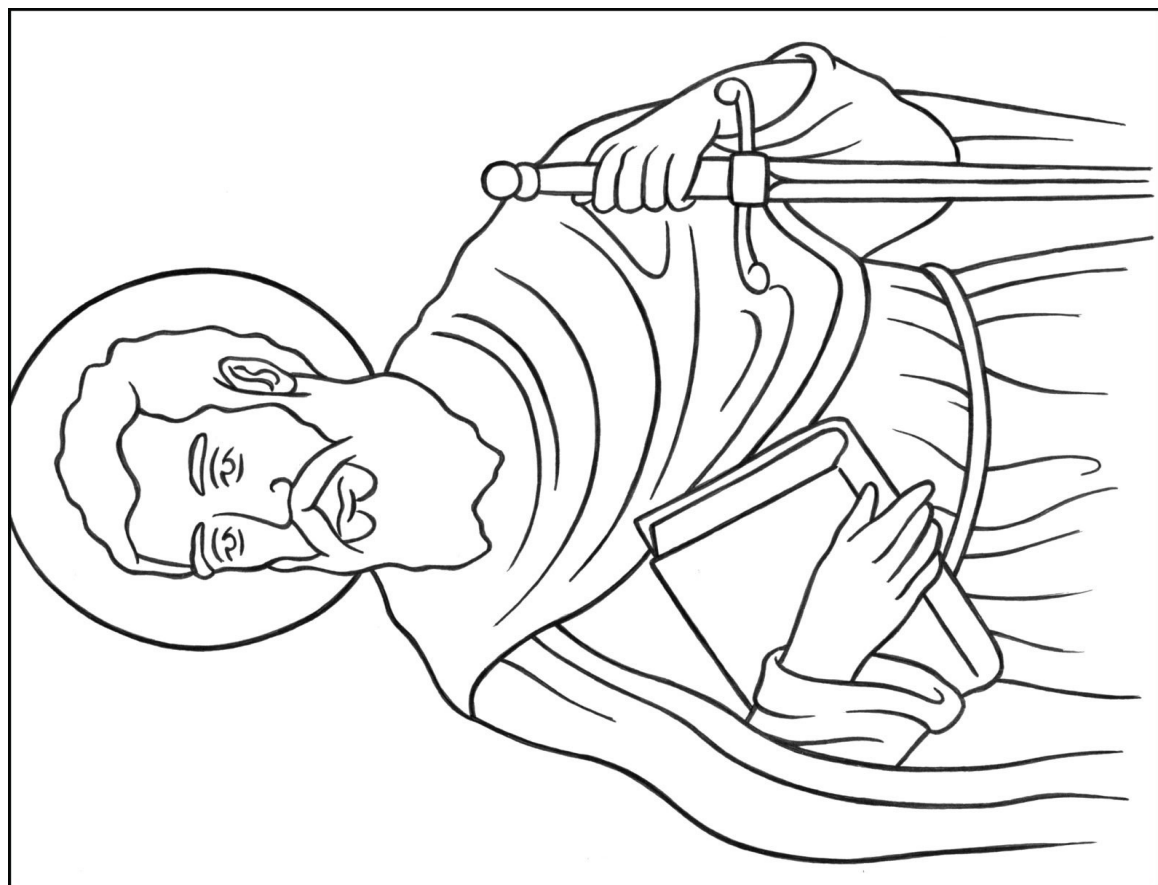
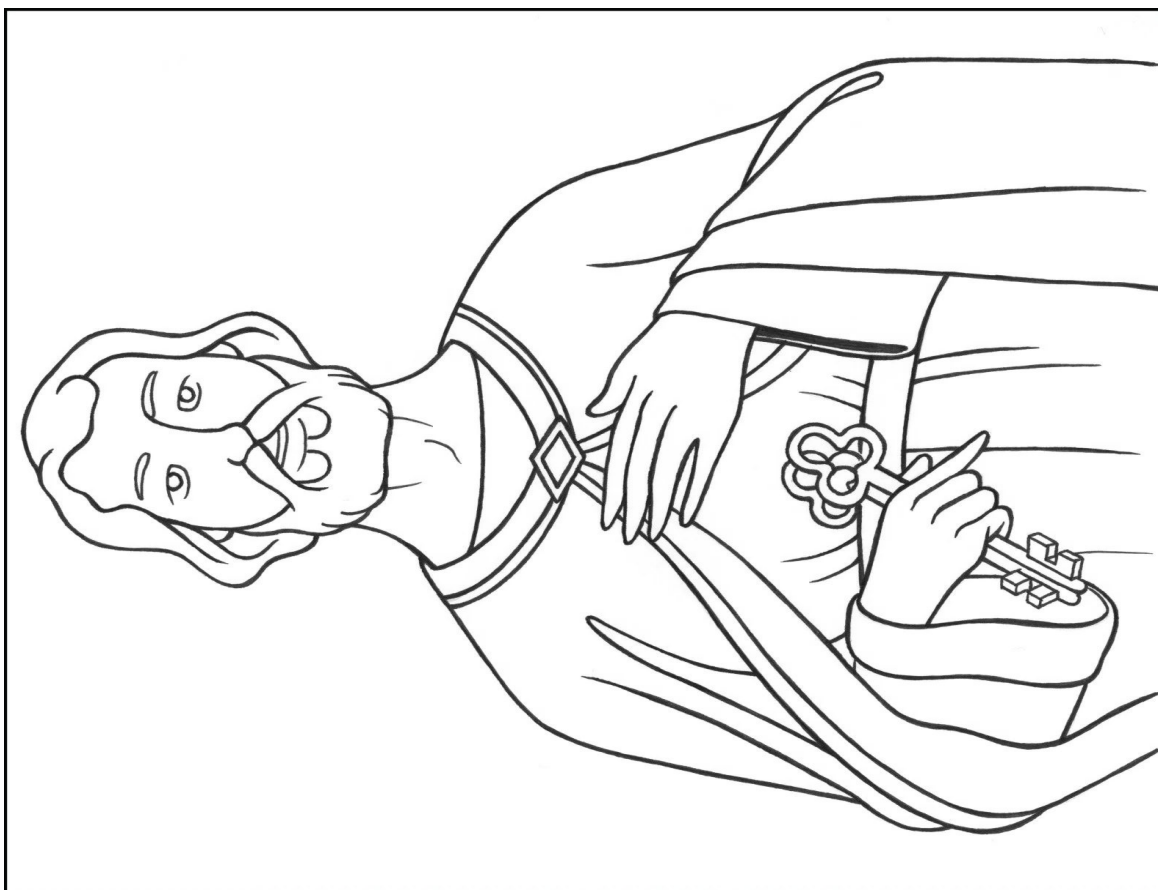



SAVE THE DATE
