## BALANCING FAITH & SPORTS

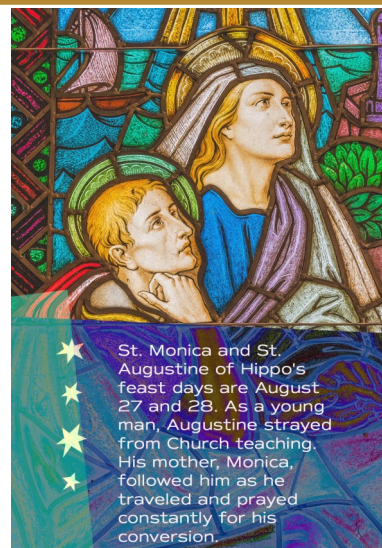
