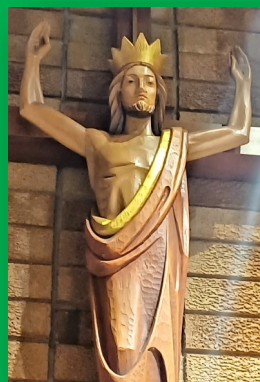

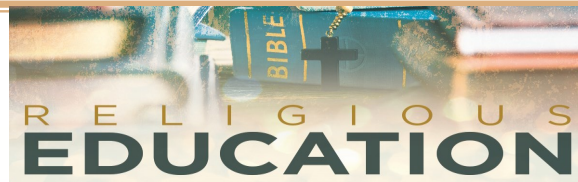

Items Needed for Food Pantry

Thank you to our parish family from the St. Vincent de Paul food pantry. Over 85 families are weekly recipients of your donations, and the pantry truly could not exist without you. Your faithfulness is a blessing to us all.

In light of this, we are reaching out to ask for your continued generosity. We currently have an abundance of mac and cheese, but we are in need of the following items:

- Canned meals, boxed meals, and side dishes
- Any canned goods
- Salsa and BBQ sauce
- Cereal and rice
- Tomato products and pasta sauces
- Condiments, spices, and seasonings
- Paper products (toilet paper, paper towels, napkins, tissues)
- Toiletries (any kind)
- Soaps (dish, laundry, and hand soap)

- There are three changes:
 - No longer a Wednesday evening option
 - Tuesday sessions are being held at Ascension of Our Lord campus
 - The start time of class has been pushed back 30 minutes
this is to elevate families having to rush to get to REP on time and students disrupting the sessions already started by coming in late.

It is important to register at your earliest convenience, so we do not have any issues with needing to make second orders of workbooks or supplies. It is extremely important to also include Baptism and if applies First Communion Certificates or just dates of Sacraments, if they were at Ascension of Our Lord or Christ the King Parish.
