Advent is a time of remembering, waiting, and preparing. Of course, we all are in a hurry for Christmas to come. In fact, for many, Christmas is over when the big day actually arrives. However, Advent is kind of like Lent; a time to slow ourselves down, give ourselves some sacred space, and prepare. Advent has 2 "parts" to it if you will—the first part is when we remember that Christ will come again at the end of time. The second part is when we are more focused on remembering the birth of Jesus— Christmas. you can stop in for confession. Something to
think about this Advent season.


Pantry Gift Gard Program




