2026-2027 Scholarship Application Information For Lakewood City Schools Students Only

2026-2027 scholarships are supported by the Lakewood Rangers Education Foundation, and are currently open for public school students enrolled in Lakewood City Schools.

There are three types of need-based aid for the Lakewood Suzuki Strings program:

Group Program Scholarships

Group Program partial and full scholarships are open for any students enrolled in kindergarten through 8th grade in the Lakewood City Schools. These scholarships cover costs for Fall or Spring group classes with Lakewood Suzuki Strings (LSS). Students must additionally be taking private lessons with LSS for the duration of the semester in order to qualify for a scholarship. Suzuki Group Program scholarship applications are due by August 15th and December 15th of every year; late applications will not be accepted.

Private Lesson Scholarships

Partial scholarships for the monthly private lesson fee are available for students enrolled in kindergarten through 8th grade in the Lakewood City Schools. *Private lesson scholarship applications are only given for students also enrolled in the Group Program.* Families are required to re-apply for private lesson scholarship on August 15th for fall semester and December 15th for spring semester; late applications will not be accepted.

Rental Instruments - Violin and Viola Only

Lakewood Suzuki Strings offers rental violins in collaboration with the LCS orchestra program. These rental instruments are available for students who are currently enrolled in Lakewood City Schools from kindergarten and up, and who qualify for free or reduced lunches. The annual rental fee for a school instrument is only \$50 - a fraction of the cost to rent or buy a quality instrument elsewhere. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis throughout the year, and must be renewed on August 15th of each year.

Please note that the instrument rental program is currently only for violin and viola, and availability is based on your child's instrument size. When applying for the rental instrument program, you will need to measure your child according to the instructions in this application.

Rental Violin/Viola Application

There are many different sizes of violins and violas, and finding the correct one for your child is crucial for their comfort while learning to play. Our rental program is based on availability of sizes, so in order to determine whether we have an instrument available, we will need you to measure your child's arm length. Please follow the instructions below and fill out the questions.

- 1) Get a ruler or tape measure ready.
- 2) Place the end of the ruler against your child's neck. Ask your child to outstretch their arm sideways without extending their shoulder.
- 3) Lay the ruler down your child's arm to their wrist. Take the measurement from the neck to the wrist.
- 4) Compare the measurement to the list below to determine the correct size instrument for your child. Please note that if your child is in between measurements, the best course of action is to size down.

Measurements in Inches

Please check your child's measurement and size from the options below:

- 13 1/4 inches or less: 1/16 size
- 14 1/4 inches: 1/10 size
- 15 1/4 inches: 1/8 size
- 17 1/4 inches: 1/4 size
- 19 inches: 1/2 size
- 20 1/2 inches: 3/4 size
- 21 1/4 inches or more: full size
