REHEARSALS

Every other Tuesday during lunch/recess in the resource room (library) and 8:00 AM before School Mass in the choir loft. A complete schedule will be provided by the start of school.

PERFORMANCES

The Children's choir generally sings at some school Masses on Wednesdays, as well as 2nd and 4th Sundays 10 AM Mass each month. They also sing for Christmas Eve at 4pm, Easter Sunday at 10 AM and Grandparents' Day Mass at 4:00 PM.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

St. Pius School children, from 4th to 8th grade are eligible, although we have a limit of 30 students because of the fire code in the choir loft.

WHAT DO WE DO?

Prepare and sing the music for mass so as to inspire the congregation to join their voices. Learn 2 harmony, rounds and partner songs. Learn how to read music, follow a conductor with good vocal technique. Some older singers will be given cantor responsibilities (singing the psalm and alleluia from the ambo). There are also solo opportunities.
