#### VII. **Principal & Dean's Report**

Survey from the Diocese, 43 families responded, about 15% of our families.

22 staff respond, 61% staff response rate

Families come here for religious and moral foundation, academic performance, individual attention given to students, Christian community atmosphere, dissatisfaction with public school.

Net Promoter Score: 63, down from 77 last year.

Mission & Catholic Identity: mostly everyone agrees that we are teaching values and commitments of Catholic church.

Governance & Leadership: most agreed that teachers/staff regularly communicate, staff are approachable, responsive to concerns.

Academic Excellence: 89% agree that they are satisfied with learning environment, how students are treated.

Operational Vitality: 83% agree school materials being available in native language with translators in meetings.

Concern that younger grades rely too heavily on screens and laptops.
