2. Finance - N/A

-Through January, school was still positive 1.7 million, 1.6 million in expenses.

-Most tuition plans are 10 month so expenses continue through the summer which is where we tend to go negative.

-At this time last year we were -\$90,000 → currently we are +\$100,000

-Budgeted to end -\$325,000 (expense expected to outrun revenue for remainder of fiscal year)

-We are collecting more tuition revenue per child

-Some of the gala money is in _____ - bulk of the revenue has not been accounted for yet. Probably will be in the next report.
