Key Terms for Understanding the Calendar



We will no longer be advertising the transport fees in our social calendar as the applicable fee varies from person to person and will be charged by \$1 per kilometre by the direct distance as per your Service Agreement.



Departure Time: Shows when the event starts or when the bus leaves from the central location, as outlined in the event description.



Return Time: Shows when the event finishes or when the bus returns to the central location, as outlined in the event description.



Easy: Flat, step-free paths under 50m, wide doors, movable seating, quiet space, fully accessible bathrooms.

Medium: Some slopes or up to 3 steps, standard doors, 50–100m walk, moderate noise, accessible bathrooms.

Hard: Uneven paths, more than 3 stairs (may lack rails), fixed seating, low lighting, over 100m walk, noisy and busy.



Supported Outings: Include Support Workers to assist participants. These are designed for CHSP Social Support Group clients and are CHSP-funded, with fees charged per hour. Support is subsidised through CHSP funding.

Unsupported Outings: No Support Workers are present, though a Volunteer may accompany. These outings are not CHSP-funded and are intended for clients who can access the community independently. The fee covers the Coordination of activities



Indicates if meals are included, available to be purchased or you Bring Your Own (BYO) meals and snacks. If no eating options are available, this is indicated with N/A.

CLIENT ADVISORY GROUP IMPORTANT UPDATE

From April, we will be transitioning our Client Advisory Groups to a new Client Representative Forum model. The March meetings will be the final sessions in the current format.

From April, each local government area will have two appointed Volunteer Client Representatives who will form the Client Representative Forum.

The Client Representative Forum will:

- Convene on a quarterly basis at accessible venues.
- Focus on a nominated theme or set topic at each meeting.
- Provide a structured mechanism for Client Representatives to consolidate and present feedback on behalf of their local communities, strengthening two-way communication with the organisation, leadership and the Board.

Client Representatives:

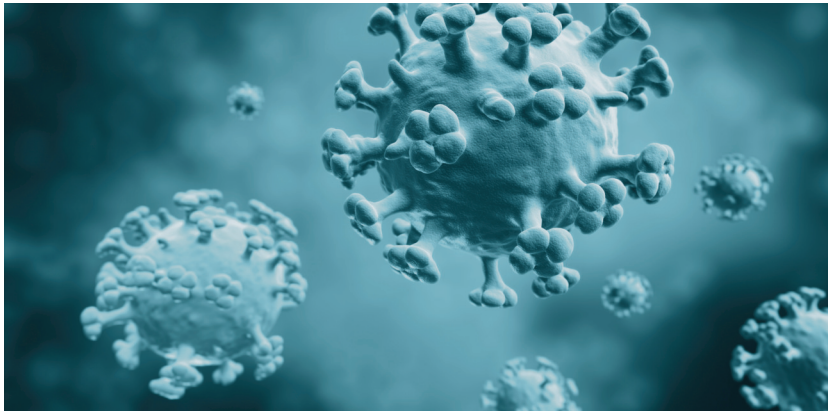
- Are formally appointed volunteers.
- Participate through a structured governance framework and regional representation model.

- Sign an approved Position Description.
- Agree to and comply with the Client Representative Forum (CRF) Terms of Reference.
- Sign and uphold the Code of Conduct.
- Meet probity requirements (photo Identification, Working With Children Check, NDIS Screening)

VACCINATIONS

As the colder months approach, us, it is recommended older members of our community arrange with their GP's to have their vaccinations for Influenza, Pneumococcal, Shingles and COVID before the season starts.

The usual peak season is between June and September.

Influenza vaccines can change from year to year regarding:

- which vaccines are registered by the Therapeutic Goods Administration
- the indicated ages of the vaccines.

WINTER HOME SAFETY

Smoke alarms

- Replace your smoke alarms if it's been more than 10 years since installation.
- Test your smoke alarm and change batteries every year.

Electric Blankets

- Check your electric blanket for frayed cords and worn-out wires.
- Always turn it off before going to sleep
- Avoid placing any heavy objects on top of it.

Hot water bottles

- Use hot tap water- not boiling water to fill your hot water bottle.
- Always cover it with a fitted cover or wrap, and never place it directly on your skin

Wheat/ Heat packs

- Always allow the pack to cool before reheating
- Follow the instructions on the pack
- Dispose of if you smell burning

Candles

- Never leave candles unattended
- Keep away from combustible materials
- Keep lighters and matches out of reach of children

Heaters

- Keep your heater on a flat, level surface
- Keep away from combustible materials
- Don't bring outdoor heaters inside

- Step 2: Sign a CHSP service agreement with Peppercorn Services.

Once you're set up, a dietitian will do a mini nutritional assessment with you, so you can choose the meal company that is best to meet your needs:

Order and Pay Yourself

- You pick your meal company and order your meals.
- You pay the company's invoice yourself.
- Send us the paid invoice, and we will contribute \$3 for every main meal or soup you ordered.

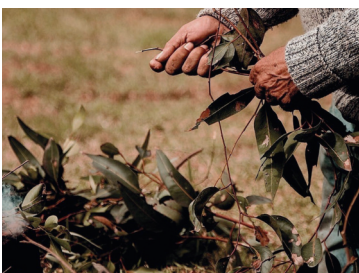
