Parenting Programs:

Circle of Security: Circle Of Security (COS) is an 8 week attachment-based program for parents/carers with children 0-8 years. COS gives you the tools to support your child's ability to manage their emotions, enhance the development of your child's self-esteem, and support you to learn how to read their emotional needs.

Triple P: This is a 5 week parenting program for parents/carers with children 0-10 years of age. Using engaging videos and real-life examples, the sessions give practical, simple strategies to help build strong, healthy relationships. It focuses on promoting positive behaviours, teaching new skills and managing challenging behaviours in calm and consistent ways.

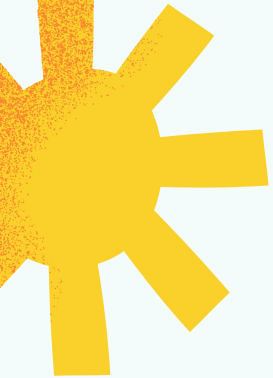

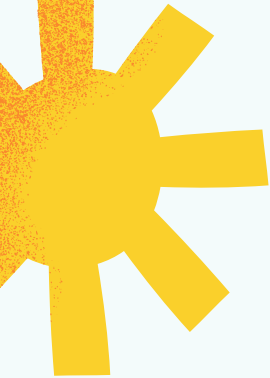

LINCS:

LINCS is a free volunteer-based home visiting support service for families living in the Hawkesbury who have at least one child under twelve and/or are pregnant. LINCS volunteers can support you when family and friends are not around or are not available.



2026 Groups:

Small Talk: Small talk is a fun, engaging supported playgroup where children can be creative, socialise and learn through play, while parents can chat with a qualified facilitator about evidence-based strategies and tips to support their parenting journey.

Family Rhyme & Rhythm: Parents, carers, and grandparents are all welcome to explore the power of sharing songs, stories and rhymes together. The Mother Goose program strengthens attachment, language development and parent/carer-child interaction in a nurturing and supportive environment.

Social Playgroup: Social playgroups are all about encouraging children and their families to connect with others through fun interactive experiences in a safe and secure environment.

Dad's & Families Playgroup: Dads, Stepdads, Grandads, and all father figures are invited to come along with their children and families for an afternoon playgroup. Afternoon tea is provided. Pack your hat and play clothes for messy garden fun!
