TRIPLE P STEPPING STONES: (7 week program)

Triple P Stepping Stones is a program specifically tailored for parents and caregivers of children ages 2-12 years with disabilities or additional needs. It can support you in encouraging positive behaviour, coping with stress, and building strong relationships with your child.

123 Magic and Emotion Coaching: (3 week program)

123 Magic and Emotion Coaching is for parents/carers with children 2-12 years. 123 Magic supports you to manage challenging behaviours, encourage positive behaviours, exploring emotion coaching and understanding stages of child development.
