FEES PAYABLE

The fees set out below cover the entire season. Full uniform is mandatory for new players. If you accept an offer of placement on a second team, an additional fee of \$150 is payable.

Junior fees Players born in 2014, 2013, 2012, 2011 & 2010	\$495 payable on registration (option to pay by instalments available)
Adult fees Mens (Seniors & Masters), Womens & Unisex	\$350 payable on registration (option to pay by instalments available)
Uniform (includes jersey and shorts, both reversible)	\$95 payable at time of order
Hills Hornets yearly registration	Miniball (U9 - U12) \$125 online, \$135 in person Juniors (U13+) \$140 online, \$150 in person Payable annually to Hills Basketball Association.

All team and club communications take place through 360Player (via desktop or app available to download for free from the [App Store](#) and [Google Play](#)).

You will need to create an account in 360Player to register for Winter comp.

ORDER YOUR UNIFORM

BHN Basketball uniform is compulsory.

Our uniforms are mandatory, not just because the Hills Basketball Association's rules say so, but so your child knows they are part of the team and they can take pride in representing our club.

HILLS HORNETS REGISTRATION

This must be paid to Hills Basketball Association before your child's first game.



NEW PLAYERS: Once your child's team has been successfully entered into the summer competition, you will receive an email from Hills Hornets prompting you to log in or create an account with them and pay for the 12 months' registration.

RETURNING PLAYERS: You will receive an email from Hills Hornets confirming the team you've been entered into.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

The fees seem more expensive than last season. Why?

The majority of our fees go towards team entry invoices, which we pay directly to Hills Basketball Association. The remaining funds help to subsidise venue hire for our training sessions, wages to our group training coaches, our 360Player software, paying a nominal fee to our admin team to enter teams as well as supporting teams throughout the season, plus various other costs in order to keep the club running.

As we are holding more group training sessions than in previous seasons, we have had to increase our fees marginally to cover these additional costs. In order to keep costs as low as possible, we rely on individuals who volunteer their time to help run the club. With the club's constant growth and subsequent time needed to run it throughout the year, paying individuals for their time is required as the roles have moved far past a full volunteer based role. Payment made to these individuals is essentially a gesture of goodwill and by no means a living wage.

Can I pay the fees in instalments?

Yes. We offer the option to pay by instalments for those who would prefer to space their payment out. You can choose your preferred payment terms when you register. If you would like to discuss alternative options, please contact assistance@bhnbasketball.com

My child's schedule is too busy for training. Can our fees be reduced if they don't attend?

No. While attendance is up to each individual family, the fees for training are mandatory for everyone.

Can I get a refund if I change my mind?

Unfortunately we can't provide refunds, except in extraordinary circumstances. Once a team has been entered for the upcoming season, each players' fees must be paid in full. For more information on our refund policy, please [click here](#).

Can my child play on two BHN teams?

As part of the registration process, you will be asked if your child would like to play on more than one team. If a spot is available and your child's skill level is considered appropriate, a position may be offered to them. Please note that allocating players to teams in their correct age group is our priority and as such, placement on a second team cannot be guaranteed. If your child is offered a spot on a second team and you accept, an additional fee of \$150 will be payable towards that team's entry fees.

My child would like to play on the same team as their friend. Is this possible?

For winter competition, we are intending to hold grading sessions for players so that we can place everyone on the most appropriate team for their skill level. As a result, we can't guarantee that friends will be kept together.

I'd like to contribute to BHN Basketball in some way. How can I help?

First of all - thank you! Volunteers are such an important part of our club, and we could use all the help we can get. There are plenty of roles available for those who are interested. The most important ones are team coaches and managers, as they're essential for each team to operate each season. If you've ever considered coaching, we encourage you to give it a go - we can provide you with a Club Mentor on game days to help you learn the ropes, and HBA runs [free coaching courses](#) offering beginner levels of accreditation.
