

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



Report to the Wabasha SWCD Board – July 24, 2025

Deanna Pomije, Soil Health Nutrient Management Specialist

Nutrient Management Work:

- Work on Adam Graner's 2026 manure management plan (1,200 acres) using MPCAs new online planner. Lately this work has been put on hold with other work pressing.
- Finalized revisions on the Comprehensive Nutrient Management Plan (CNMP) 390 acres for Ted Mehrkens for EQIP, collaborating with Kate Bruss, TSA and reviewer Aaron Janz, NRCS. I plan to also complete a Manure Management Plan for them as required by MPCA & their annual 2026 manure management plan.
 - NRCS staff finished their review of the plan. Need to set aside time for these revisions, mostly mapping updates needed.

Soil Health Work:

- No-till drill rental season for warm season grass seeding has passed with three producers
 using renting it. A couple have already signed rental contracts for cool season grass
 planting for Aug./ Sept. We are bringing Ella up-to-speed on lending out our rental
 equipment. To date for this year the drill has been used on 82 acres, 8 producers.
- Working through the certification of no-till under two contracts, two farms with Alan
 Jostock. The payment voucher has been sent to NRCS staff for JAA approval. His contracts
 also include cover crops.

Cover Crops:

• The latter part of this month was spent talking with cover crop interests and processing their applications. Signing them up involves FSA and NRCS eligibility checks. Developing a contract and seeding plan. Requesting job approval sign off on the seeding plans by TSA staff. Discussions with producers on their operation specifics and how cover crops fit into it for improving their soil health. Completing an NRCS environmental review form for each contract. We have 9 preliminary batched RCPP applications in process. This entails 398 acres and a request for \$78,775 with \$71,225 remaining in the current pending contract. There are ~26 additional potential interests for cover crops yet to contact or work through for possible contracts. In Aug. I plan to complete some soil health field assessments and Haney test soil collections.

Outreach & Client Contacts:

Breakfast on the Farm at Lehnertz 7/12:

Set up a booth/tent for this event with Matt. Demonstrated the soil stability test and had activity sheets for children. This was a very well attended event (1,100+) with many families visiting the farm.

West Indian Creek Gathering 7/16:

Had a great WIC Gathering on the 16th with about 25 people attending. I helped other staff in preparing for this event. Put together the sign-up sheet with seed mix option for the offered drone cover crop planting for those in the watershed. TJ Kartes, the agronomy salesman helped present on the agronomy aspects of the drone cover crop planting. His input was quite helpful. To-date we have 4 producers signed up for the WIC drone cover crop planting, totaling 209 acres.

• Ideas for soil health demos (soil stability test) at the county fair – planning to present around characteristics of our end goal; good health soil, what it looks like and how to test for it.

Coffee 'n Conservation:

- Next planned event will be in August yet to be determined.
- June 25 the 'Coffee & Conservation' returned to the Legion in Plainview with a guest speaker, John Rosenow with a dairy operation in WI. He shared his story on how he composts his dairy manure. This was a great informal Q & A session with 5 people attending.
 - o 21 total to-date producers / landowners in attendance
 - Great conversation around a variety of conservation topics: erosion, nutrient management, cover crops, tillage, weed control & manure composting.
 - o Flyer prep., email call text producers for attendance
- Plan to transition these events to every other month to do a better job at outreach, getting
 people to attend and allowing enough time for cover crop and nutrient management work.

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

The specific operation and maintenance requirements for the conservation practice listed are described in the operation and maintenance plan prepared for this contract by the technical assistance provider.
- 2. Should the land occupier fail to maintain the practice during its effective life, the land occupier is liable to the State of Minnesota for the amount up to 150% of the amount of financial assistance received to install and establish the practice unless the failure was caused by reasons beyond the land occupier's control, or if conservation practices are applied at the land occupier's expense that provide equivalent protection of the soil and water resources.
- 3. If title to this land is transferred to another party before expiration of the aforementioned life, it shall be the responsibility of the landowner who signed this contract to advise the new owner that this contract is in force and to notify other parties to the contract of the transfer.
- 4. Practice(s) must be planned and installed in accordance with technical standards and specifications of the:

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- 5. Increases in the practice units or cost must be approved by the organization board through amendment of this contract as a condition to increase the cost-share payments.
- 6. This contract, when approved by the organization board or council, will remain in effect unless canceled or amended by mutual agreement, except where installations of practices covered by this contract have not been installed by 11/1/24, 11/1/25, 11/1/26, this contract will be automatically terminated on that date.
- Reimbursement requests must be supported by a completed voucher.


