



Gospel Reflection

Matthew 17:1-9

For the second Sunday of Lent, we move from Jesus' retreat to the desert to his Transfiguration. Each year on the first Sunday of Lent, our Gospel tells the story of Jesus' temptation in the desert. On the second Sunday of Lent each year, we hear the story of Jesus' Transfiguration.

The story of Jesus' Transfiguration is told in the three Synoptic Gospels: Matthew, Mark, and Luke. In each of those Gospels, the Transfiguration follows Jesus' first prediction of his death and his teaching about the costs of discipleship. Jesus' Transfiguration is a promise of Jesus' glory, his Resurrection.

On a mountain in today's reading, a voice affirms that Jesus is God's Son in words reminiscent of the voice at Jesus' baptism. In addition, the appearance of Moses and Elijah on the mountain connects this story with God's relationship to the people of Israel. Moses and Elijah represent the Law and the Prophets, respectively. Together with Jesus, they represent God's complete Word.

The Transfiguration occurs in the presence of just three of Jesus' disciples: Peter, James, and John. In Matthew's Gospel, those disciples are among the first whom Jesus calls. The three men are identified as an "inner circle" among Jesus' disciples when Jesus asks them to accompany him to the Garden of Gethsemane just before his arrest.

Reflexión del Evangelio

Mateo 17:1-9

Para el segundo domingo de Cuaresma, pasamos del retiro de Jesús en el desierto a su Transfiguración. Cada año, el primer domingo de Cuaresma, el Evangelio narra la historia de la tentación de Jesús en el desierto. El segundo domingo de Cuaresma, escuchamos la historia de la Transfiguración de Jesús.

La historia de la Transfiguración de Jesús se narra en los tres Evangelios sinópticos: Mateo, Marcos y Lucas. En cada uno de ellos, la Transfiguración sigue a la primera predicción de Jesús sobre su muerte y a su enseñanza sobre el precio del discipulado. La Transfiguración de Jesús es una promesa de su gloria, de su Resurrección.

En una montaña, en la lectura de hoy, una voz afirma que Jesús es el Hijo de Dios con palabras que recuerdan la voz que se escuchó en el bautismo de Jesús. Además, la aparición de Moisés y Elías en la montaña conecta esta historia con la relación de Dios con el pueblo de Israel. Moisés y Elías representan la Ley y los Profetas, respectivamente. Junto con Jesús, representan la Palabra completa de Dios.

La Transfiguración ocurre en presencia de solo tres de los discípulos de Jesús: Pedro, Santiago y Juan. En el Evangelio de Mateo, estos discípulos se encuentran entre los primeros a quienes Jesús llama. Los tres son identificados como un "círculo íntimo" entre los discípulos de Jesús cuando este les pide que lo acompañen al Huerto de Getsemaní, poco antes de su arresto.

Stewardship

It's difficult to teach or practice stewardship, unless we have a clear understanding of exactly what stewardship is. If we wish to embrace stewardship, we must gradually learn to embrace every definition or aspect of stewardship.

"The Lord said to Abram.... 'I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, so that you will be a blessing.'" Genesis 12:1-2

In Baptism, God says the same thing to each of us. Stewardship is our response to our baptismal call. The stewardship lifestyle can unlock our full potential.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Olive oil looms large in the vocabulary of baptism. There are other oils in the pantry closet, from grapeseed to safflower to canola, but only olives yield the proper meanings. Olives don't just happen; they are cultivated, nurtured, pruned, and fussed over; they are a sign of human and divine cooperation. Olives can thrive in poor soil, but they cannot survive without human ingenuity, planting shoots and pruning branches. They can't be popped from a tree and munched like apples: they are inedible without long curing; neither do they yield their oil to hand pressure alone, but only to huge stone mills. Abundant patience is needed as sediment sinks to the bottom of storage barrels and pure oil rises to the surface.

Olive oil is a byproduct of peace: war keeps harvesters, planters, and pruners within city walls and turns millers into soldiers. To obtain oil from olives you need vast measures of hope, patience, faith, and ingenuity. Olive oil is a sign of God's bounty and the way we human beings collaborate with God to bring about impossibly wonderful results. It is creation at its finest. Some people give chocolate eggs for Easter; perhaps olive oil is a more appropriate gift!


