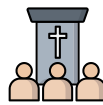

"... el que crea en mí, hará las obras que hago yo y las hará aun mayores, porque yo me voy al Padre..." Juan 14:12

La mayordomía es una respuesta de fe. Las buenas obras que realizamos son el resultado de nuestra fe, no la causa de nuestra fe. La mayordomía surge de una conversión auténtica a la fe.



Reflexión del Evangelio

Juan 14, 1:12

Las lecturas de los últimos domingos han tratado sobre la Resurrección; sin embargo, el Evangelio de hoy nos transporta en el tiempo a un acontecimiento de la vida de Jesús anterior a su Pasión. Jesús les dice a sus discípulos que va a prepararles un lugar en la casa de su Padre. Les promete que, adonde él va, sus discípulos podrán seguirlo. Tomás —quien más tarde dudaría de los testimonios de los discípulos acerca de haber visto al Señor Resucitado— contradice a Jesús al afirmar que los discípulos no saben adónde se dirige Jesús ni cómo llegar hasta allí. Jesús les explica que él mismo es el camino, la verdad y la vida. Al conocer y amar a Jesús, los discípulos aman ahora también a Dios Padre.

Entonces, Felipe formula una petición que pone a prueba las palabras de Jesús. Felipe desea que Jesús les muestre el Padre a los discípulos. Recordemos que Jesús acaba de decirles a sus discípulos: «Si me conocen a mí, conocerán también a mi Padre. Desde ahora ya lo conocen y lo han visto». Como buen maestro, Jesús responde a Felipe repitiendo y profundizando en lo que acaba de decirles a los discípulos: puesto que han visto y conocido a Jesús, han visto y conocido también al Padre. Luego, Jesús les ofrece otra palabra de consuelo respecto a su partida: gracias a su fe en Dios y en Jesús, los discípulos realizarán las mismas obras que Jesús ha realizado, e incluso mayores.

La conexión entre Jesús y su Padre —entre la obra de Jesús y la obra del Padre— queda claramente manifestada en el Evangelio de hoy. Jesús está en el Padre, y Dios Padre está en Jesús. Del mismo modo en que Dios reveló su nombre a Moisés —«Yo soy»—, así también Jesús revela su nombre a sus discípulos: «Yo soy el camino, la verdad y la vida».

La revelación de la Trinidad se completa en el pasaje que sigue a la lectura de hoy, el cual constituye el Evangelio del próximo domingo. Dado que Jesús se marcha, el Padre enviará en nombre de Jesús al Paráclito —el Espíritu Santo—, quien dará continuidad a la obra del Padre y de Jesús.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

If there is such a thing as a Catholic "trademark" it is the sign of the cross, first traced on the senses of catechumens as they begin the journey to baptism, or on the forehead of an infant who is brought to the doors of the church at baptism.

As early as the third century, Christians were tracing the sign of the cross on their bodies. At first, the cross was traced on the forehead during times of prayer and daily occupations. We use a similar small cross today as we trace the cross over on the forehead, lips, and heart at the Gospel during Mass. Much later, the full-body sign traced from forehead to heart to shoulders took shape, perhaps copying the priest's gesture of blessing with the consecrated host during Mass. Today, this superb baptismal gift is a sign of belonging to Christ and the community, a way of focusing our attention, of asking for God's blessing, of tracing on our shoulders a willingness to find meaning in life's burdens. In the sign of the cross, we have an ever-available means of expressing gratitude for our baptism.

TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

El 20 de abril de 1906 los ojos de una imagen de la Dolorosa comenzaron a parpadear durante un lapso de 15 minutos en el colegio jesuita San Gabriel, en Quito, Ecuador. En 1995 en Cochabamba, Bolivia, donde una imagen del Divino rostro lagrimó sangre y después, una imagen de la Inmaculada hizo lo mismo. En el transcurso del siglo veinte, muchísimas imágenes de Cristo, María e incluso, el Espíritu Santo, lloraron lágrimas de agua, sangre u óleo, emitieron aroma de rosa o mostraron alguna manifestación paranormal.

La ciencia logró explicar algunos de estos fenómenos, pero en muchos casos no fue posible. Normalmente, la jerarquía eclesíastica prefiere no hacer declaraciones oficiales al respecto, por lo menos, no antes de mucho escrutinio. El apóstol san Juan recomienda examinar cada espíritu (1 Juan 4:1-3) y esto es lo que la Iglesia hace con estas manifestaciones sobrenaturales. Con investigaciones científicas, sociales y espirituales se examinan cuidadosamente estas manifestaciones a fin de asegurar que provienen de Dios y no del diablo u otros orígenes. En fin, la mejor prueba de la veracidad de estos fenómenos es la conversión de los fieles.

Stewardship

Stewardship is how we walk that path each day, recognizing that all we have is a gift from God and responding with gratitude by sharing our time, talent, and treasure.

"... the one who believes in me will do the works that I do, and in fact will do greater ones than these..." John 14:12

Stewardship is a faith response. The good works we perform are the result of our faith, not the cause of our faith. Stewardship flows from a genuine faith conversion.

Gospel Reflection

John 14:1-12

The readings for the last few Sundays have been about the Resurrection, but today's Gospel takes us back in time to an event in Jesus' life before his Passion. Jesus tells his disciples that he is going to prepare a place for them in his Father's house. He promises that where he is going, his disciples will be able to follow. Thomas, who will later doubt the disciples' reports that they have seen the Risen Lord, contradicts Jesus by saying that the disciples don't know where Jesus is going or how to get there. Jesus explains that he himself is the way, the truth, and the life. In knowing and loving Jesus, the disciples now love God the Father.

Philip then makes a request that challenges Jesus' words. Philip wants Jesus to show the Father to the disciples. Recall that Jesus has just told his disciples, "If you know me, then you will also know my Father. From now on you do know him and have seen him." As a good teacher, Jesus responds to Philip by repeating and elaborating on what he has just told the disciples: they have seen and known Jesus, so they have seen and known the Father. Then Jesus offers another reassurance about his departure: because of faith in God and in Jesus, the disciples will do the work that Jesus has done and more.

The connection between Jesus and his Father, between Jesus' work and the work of the Father, is made clear in today's Gospel. Jesus is in the Father, and God the Father is in Jesus. As God spoke his name to Moses, "I am," so too Jesus speaks his name to his disciples: "I am the way and the truth and the life."

The revelation of the Trinity is completed in the passage that follows today's reading, and it is the Gospel for next Sunday. Because Jesus goes away, the Father will send in Jesus' name the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, who will continue the work of the Father and of Jesus.

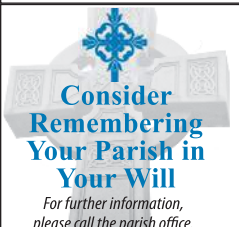

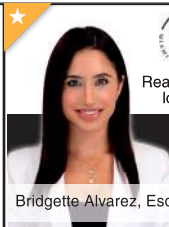
