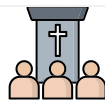

And yet God, who is always merciful even when he punishes, "put a mark on Cain, lest any who came upon him should kill him" (Gn 4:15). He thus gave him a distinctive sign, not to condemn him to the hatred of others, but to protect and defend him from those wishing to kill him, even out of a desire to avenge Abel's death. Not even a murderer loses his personal dignity, and God himself pledges to guarantee this.⁶

Gospel Reflection

Matthew 14:22-33

Today's Gospel directly follows last week's account of Jesus feeding a crowd of more than 5,000 people with just five loaves of bread and two fish. For the sake of the crowds, Jesus had postponed his time of solitude. Now, at last, Jesus finds some time for quiet and prayer. He sends his disciples ahead of him by boat, dismisses the crowds, and then withdraws to the mountain to pray.

The disciples do not fare well. They struggle to weather the wind and waves, making little progress in their journey. We are reminded of a previous story in Chapter 8 of Matthew's Gospel, when Jesus calms the seas. This time, however, Jesus does not calm the seas, and the disciples do not express fear until they see Jesus walking toward them on the water. In this story it is not the storm that is feared but the sight of Jesus before them, whom they mistake for a ghost.

Clues like these suggest that this story is about the disciples' growing understanding of the identity of Jesus. In continuity with last week's Gospel about the feeding of the multitude, today's Gospel is also about what the disciples' faith in Jesus will enable them to do. In last week's Gospel, when the disciples see the crowds, they ask Jesus to send the crowds away. Jesus turns the situation around, telling the disciples to feed the crowd with the provisions that they have. Both of these Gospels tell us much about ministry.

Jesus calls to the disciples and calms their fears. He is not a ghost. The impulsive Peter seeks proof that the person is indeed Jesus. He asks Jesus to call him out onto the water, and Jesus grants this request. Peter's fear and doubt overtake him, however, once he is walking on the water. Jesus reaches out to Peter and saves him. When Jesus and Peter enter the boat, Matthew reports that the wind ceases, and the disciples confess that Jesus is the Son of God.

Faith in Jesus will enable the disciples to do the work that Jesus has done. Peter walks on water. The five loaves and two fish feed a multitude of people. The disciples can and will participate in the work of the kingdom of heaven. When Peter fears and doubts the person of Jesus, however, he falters. Peter's example teaches us that true Christian ministry emerges from the faith that Jesus is the Messiah, God's only Son.

Reflexión del Evangelio

Mateo 14:22-33

El Evangelio de hoy continúa directamente el relato de la semana pasada sobre cómo Jesús alimentó a una multitud de más de 5.000 personas con solo cinco panes y dos peces. Jesús había pospuesto su tiempo de soledad por el bien de la multitud. Ahora, por fin, encuentra un momento de tranquilidad y oración. Envía a sus discípulos por delante en la barca, despide a la multitud y luego se retira a la montaña para orar.

A los discípulos no les va bien. Luchan contra el viento y las olas, avanzando muy poco en su travesía. Esto nos recuerda un relato anterior, en el capítulo 8 del Evangelio de Mateo, cuando Jesús calma el mar. Sin embargo, esta vez Jesús no calma el mar, y los discípulos no sienten miedo hasta que ven a Jesús caminando hacia ellos sobre las aguas. En este relato, lo que provoca temor no es la tormenta, sino la visión de Jesús ante ellos, a quien confunden con un fantasma.

Detalles como estos sugieren que esta historia trata sobre la creciente comprensión que tienen los discípulos de la identidad de Jesús. En continuidad con el Evangelio de la semana pasada sobre la multiplicación de los panes, el Evangelio de hoy también aborda lo que la fe en Jesús permitirá a los discípulos realizar. En el Evangelio de la semana pasada, al ver a la multitud, los discípulos piden a Jesús que la despida. Jesús da un giro a la situación y les dice que alimenten a la gente con las provisiones que tienen. Ambos relatos nos enseñan mucho sobre el ministerio.

Jesús llama a los discípulos y calma sus temores; no es un fantasma. Pedro, impulsivo, busca una prueba de que quien está allí es realmente Jesús. Le pide a Jesús que lo llame para caminar sobre el agua, y Jesús accede a su petición. Sin embargo, una vez que está caminando sobre el agua, el miedo y la duda se apoderan de Pedro. Jesús tiende la mano a Pedro y lo salva. Cuando ambos suben a la barca, Mateo relata que el viento cesa y los discípulos confiesan que Jesús es el Hijo de Dios.

La fe en Jesús capacitará a los discípulos para realizar la obra que Jesús ha hecho. Pedro camina sobre el agua. Los cinco panes y los dos peces alimentan a una multitud. Los discípulos pueden participar —y participarán— en la obra del Reino de los Cielos. Sin embargo, cuando Pedro siente temor y duda respecto a la persona de Jesús, vacila. El ejemplo de Pedro nos enseña que el verdadero ministerio cristiano surge de la fe en que Jesús es el Mesías, el Hijo único de Dios.
