Gospel Reflection

Matthew 11:2-11

The third Sunday of Advent is traditionally called *Gaudete Sunday*. *Gaudete* is the Latin word meaning “rejoice.” This Sunday is so named because “Rejoice” is the first word in the entrance antiphon for today’s Mass taken from Philippians 4:4,5: “Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice! The Lord is near.” Some people mark this Sunday on their Advent wreath with a pink candle instead of a purple candle. This Sunday is a joyful reminder that our salvation is near.

This week’s Gospel Reading continues our Advent reflection on the person and message of John the Baptist. Last week we heard John speak about his relationship to the coming Messiah, Jesus. This week, we hear Jesus’ message to John the Baptist, now in prison, about the signs of the kingdom found in Jesus’ ministry and Jesus’ assessment of John’s role in the Kingdom of God.

The Gospel of Matthew tells the story of John’s arrest in chapter [14:3-12](#). In today’s Gospel, John sends word to Jesus from prison, asking if Jesus is the Messiah for whom he has been waiting. Jesus responds by pointing to the miracles that he has worked and invites John and the other hearers to make their own determination. In his next breath, however, Jesus praises John for his role in preparing the way for Jesus. Then Jesus says that all of those who work for the Kingdom of God will be as great as John and even greater.

Jesus’ message to John about the signs of the kingdom being performed recalls the salvation described by the prophet Isaiah. This passage is a reminder that the beginning of salvation is already mysteriously present to us, but also yet to be fulfilled. Salvation is already in our midst as manifest in the miraculous deeds of Jesus and in the Church. But salvation is also to be fulfilled in the coming reign of God. Even as we observe our world today, we can find glimpses of God’s work among us. Even more, we help to prepare the way for God’s kingdom by our words and our deeds. This message is indeed a cause for rejoicing.

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Reflexión del Evangelio

Matthew 11:2-11

El tercer domingo de Adviento se llama tradicionalmente Domingo de Gaudete. Gaudete es la palabra latina que significa “alégrense”. Este domingo recibe este nombre porque “Alégrense” es la primera palabra de la antífona de entrada de la Misa de hoy, tomada de Filipenses 4:4-5: “Alégrense siempre en el Señor; lo repito: ¡Alégrense! El Señor está cerca”. Algunas personas marcan este domingo en su corona de Adviento con una vela rosa en lugar de una vela morada. Este domingo es un recordatorio gozoso de que nuestra salvación está cerca.

La lectura del Evangelio de esta semana continúa nuestra reflexión de Adviento sobre la persona y el mensaje de Juan el Bautista. La semana pasada escuchamos a Juan hablar sobre su relación con el Mesías que vendría, Jesús. Esta semana, escuchamos el mensaje de Jesús a Juan el Bautista, ahora en prisión, sobre los signos del reino presentes en el ministerio de Jesús y la valoración que Jesús hace del papel de Juan en el Reino de Dios.

El Evangelio de Mateo narra la historia del arresto de Juan en el capítulo 14:3-12. En el Evangelio de hoy, Juan envía un mensaje a Jesús desde la prisión, preguntándole si Jesús es el Mesías que ha estado esperando. Jesús responde señalando los milagros que ha realizado e invita a Juan y a los demás a que saquen sus propias conclusiones. Sin embargo, a continuación, Jesús alaba a Juan por su papel en la preparación del camino para Jesús. Luego, Jesús dice que todos aquellos que trabajan por el Reino de Dios serán tan grandes como Juan, e incluso mayores.

El mensaje de Jesús a Juan sobre los signos del reino que se están manifestando recuerda la salvación descrita por el profeta Isaías. Este pasaje nos recuerda que el comienzo de la salvación ya está misteriosamente presente entre nosotros, pero aún no se ha cumplido plenamente. La salvación ya está en medio de nosotros, manifestada en las obras milagrosas de Jesús y en la Iglesia. Pero la salvación también se cumplirá en el reino venidero de Dios. Incluso al observar nuestro mundo hoy, podemos vislumbrar la obra de Dios entre nosotros. Más aún, ayudamos a preparar el camino para el reino de Dios con nuestras palabras y nuestras acciones. Este mensaje es, sin duda, motivo de alegría.
