Oxford County Financial Services RFP Questions and Answers – December 29, 2023

Q: What bookkeeping software does the county currently use? Are you willing to change?

A: The County does not have any bookkeeping software. We expect bidders to include the cost and operation of bookkeeping software in their bid.

Q: Is there a separate system used for payroll, such as ADP?

A: The County uses AOD (Attendance On Demand) and may be open to changing systems if needed.

Q: How many employees?

A: Employee count fluctuates between 100-120 employees including all part-time, full-time, elected, etc.

Q: Is there an option to change financial software (if not Quickbooks or Intacct)?

A: We expect bidders to include the cost and operation of bookkeeping software in their bid.

Q: Can the services be provided remotely?

A: Yes, we expect services to be provided remotely with some in-person meetings as needed.

Q: Are these services currently provided by a consultant, or are/were they handled by an internal employee(s)?

A: Services are currently provided by a CPA firm.

- a. If a consultant, approximately how many hours a week does the current firm average?
 A: 1400 hours annually some of that includes busy weeks around budget time.
 Consultant tracked total running hours, not weekly hours so we don't have that data unfortunately.
- b. If an employee(s), What is the current/typical FTE count?A: When the County did have internal employees doing this work, there were two.

Q: Expected Budget for these services?

A: \$120,000 per year is what we are currently budgeting for these services.
