What is the HRIC Soup & Sandwich Program?



Parishioners in the three churches of our Collaborative donate food to the Good Shepherd Center & Soup Kitchen twice a month. The food donated is mostly sandwiches: cold cuts and cheese or PB&J. Some of the food donated by our generous parishioners is in the form of casseroles or soup. Others donate drink mixes, cookies, chips, or fruits and vegetables. Your donations make a huge difference in helping people find a nourishing meal and a glimmer of hope in their challenging lives.

The Good Shepherd Center and Soup Kitchen, part of Lazarus House Ministries in Lawrence, MA houses a community day center and a soup kitchen. The soup kitchen serves a continental breakfast and a hot, nutritious noontime meal to anyone who comes through its doors. For many of the guests, the meals they eat at the soup kitchen may very well be their only food of the day. Meals are served by volunteers within the community who generously donate their time, compassion, and a listening ear. **The nutritious and comforting food and beverages that are offered at the soup kitchen come exclusively from donations by individuals, businesses, synagogues, churches, schools, civic organizations and many others.** It is through the generosity and compassion of many that they are most gratefully able to provide these much needed goods and services.

The Good Shepherd Soup Kitchen provides freshly prepared hot meals for more than 300 people a day at breakfast and lunch sittings. The soup kitchen program also offers the community a safe place to gather, interact, pick up some personal care items, and work with a Community Resource Specialist to get help with accessing services and navigating the steps to complete government or agency forms and applications.

Please consider being part of this important initiative. If you are interested in feeding the hungry by donating sandwiches, soups, casseroles, drink mixes, goodies, or any other items, just drop by St. Ann Church Hall from 7:00 a.m.–9:00 a.m. on the second and fourth Wednesdays of the month with your much needed offering. No need to sign up! Volunteers take care of driving the donations to The Good Shepherd Center. It's easy and fulfilling!

Containers for soup donations and foil pans for casserole donations will be provided. Pick up the container and/or foil pan(s) for the next delivery date, at the St. Ann Church Hall from 7:00 a.m.–9:00 a.m. on the second and fourth Wednesdays of the month. Someone is always available at this time to answer any and all questions you may have and offer you support and encouragement to get involved in a very rewarding ministry.

The Pelican Intervention Fund

Fellow Parishioners,

We are writing to express our gratitude for your financial support. In the last 12 months, we funded 31 people into 12-step residential sober living programs.

Through the collaboratives optional **Pelican Intervention Fund envelopes**, you've donated over \$21,000 which supported 15 men and women into long-term 12-step sober living programs. This brings our total to 173 clients that you've helped support since our founding in 2015.

All donations go directly into the charitable holding company (Essex County Community Foundation) which provides our non-profit status. Funds reside in ECCF's money market account, these funds are used to place clients into 12-step residency programs. 98% of donations are used to place clients (the remaining 2% pays for website domain and hosting fees, ECCF holding fee, envelopes, stamps, etc.)

There are no paid employees at the Pelican Intervention Fund, we are a totally volunteer-based organization.

Your generosity allows us to continue our mission of supporting men and women struggling with addiction by funding them into residential 12-step sober living programs.

As you may know, Federal, State, and Private insurance companies only fund medically based treatment (i.e., Suboxone / methadone / etc.) and won't fund or support 12-step recovery due to its faith-based approach.

While it's difficult to find exact success rates of all the treatment options, there's growing evidence that 12-step programs are more effective than medically based and psychotherapeutic programs.

You've probably heard Kim and me talk about the Pelican Intervention Fund and the 12-step recovery program, but I don't think we ever presented the actual 12 steps, Fr. Tim suggested we take this opportunity to share them with you.

The 12 Steps

1. We admitted we were powerless over alcohol / drugs—that our lives had become unmanageable.
2. Came to believe that a Power greater than ourselves could restore us to sanity.
3. Decided to turn our will and our lives over to the care of God as we understood Him.
4. Made a searching and fearless moral inventory of ourselves.
5. Admitted to God, to ourselves, and to another human being the exact nature of our wrongs.
6. Were entirely ready to have God remove all these defects of character.
7. Humbly asked Him to remove our shortcomings.
8. Made a list of all persons we had harmed and became willing to make amends to them all.
9. Made direct amends to such people wherever possible, except when to do so would injure them or others.
10. Continued to take personal inventory and when we were wrong promptly admitted it.
11. Sought through prayer and meditation to improve our conscious contact with God as we understood Him, praying only for knowledge of His will for us and the power to carry that out.
12. Having had a spiritual awakening as the result of these steps, we carry this message to those in recovery, and to practice these principles in all our affairs.

Thank-you again for your continued donations.

We are truly humbled and grateful for your overwhelming generosity and support. May God bless you and your loved ones this new year!

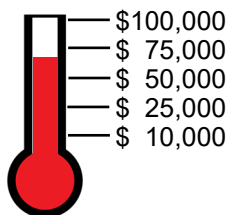
