## LA Wildfires Relief Collection

**Second Collection This Weekend (Feb. 8–9)**

The enormity of the tragedy that has unfolded in Southern California as a result of the wildfires is heartbreaking. The wildfires have killed 28 people with the expectation that number could increase. More than 15,400 structures have been destroyed. 40,000 acres have been impacted. There have been many injured, homes and businesses destroyed, and entire neighborhoods wiped out.

Thousands of brave firefighters and other first responders have been working around the clock to contain and put out the fires.

Recognizing the immediate and growing needs, Catholic Charities USA is seeking assistance for relief efforts in response to the wildfires. In the spirit of solidarity, Archbishop Henning is asking us to have a special collection to support Catholic Charities relief efforts.

We are confident our brothers and sisters in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles would welcome our support.

## The Sacrament of the Sick

## Directed Lenten Retreat

**Lent: A Time of Choice, Challenge and Change,**  
*Exploring the cost of becoming Jesus' disciple  
 by carrying your cross each day.*

*If anyone wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross daily and follow me. For whoever wishes to finds his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. (Lk. 9:23–24)*

Ash Wednesday begins the Lenten season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that leads to Easter with a call to turn away from sin, repent, and return to the gospel and ashes that mark us as followers of Christ. Lenten ashes symbolize humility and the need to develop a spirit of sacrifice for others and surrender of self to God. They remind us that humans are mortal and will return to dust and now is time to say "Yes" to Jesus' invitation. As you are marked with ashes you say "Yes" to Jesus' call to change and follow him. Ashes are a public proclamation of your desire and intention to die to self and live in Jesus the Christ.

This retreat will focus on the inner work of Lent signified by the outward sign of ashes. It will provide a time and space to engage in interior work to support and explore your public proclamation and respond to Jesus' call. Lent is a time of choice, challenge, and change. In Luke we hear Jesus invite us to follow him if we are willing to pay the cost of discipleship and be changed. What concretely, does Jesus mean by this?

Richard Rohr's response to this question with insights gathered from James Martin's book, *Jesus: A Pilgrimage*, namely taking up your cross daily and giving up your life in order to find a deeper life in Christ means six interpenetrating things that we will explore along with other questions. Why is suffering necessary and salvific? What supports you to change? How do you pray? What is hard to surrender? Where do you resist change? Do you believe in Jesus' promise? The season of Lent calls us to reflect on and explore such questions with faith.

I will provide material for reading and reflection from scripture and a variety of spiritual teachers that reflect your unique relationship with God as we explore these and other questions you may have. We will meet for four in-person or Zoom spiritual direction sessions you schedule throughout the retreat. As we open ourselves to the Holy Spirit's wisdom, I will listen deeply as you share, and together, we allow the Holy Spirit to move us and bless and guide our sharing. This offering is designed to provide an affordable, convenient retreat that creates an intimate space for you to share yourself deeply with the Holy Spirit's guidance.


## Winter Weather Mass Cancellations

## IC Haiti Update Report

February 2025—Part 2

Haiti is currently navigating extremely challenging conditions, marked by heightened insecurity. Yet, as we reported in the December 2024 HRIC Collaborative bulletins, IC Haiti's mission to support the rural school community in Puit Chacha and the medical facility in Fond des Blancs continues despite Haiti's ongoing crisis.

Before the Fr. Marc Piché elementary school opened, parents in the Puit Chacha community had to send their children several kilometers away by foot in search of education. When this was not possible, many children were forced to stay home.

However, since 2010 the Fr. Marc Piché elementary school has offered school age children a stable educational environment along with a hot lunch program daily. And, since 2017, IC Haiti has also provided tuition for those students who continue a secondary school education in nearby Fond des Blancs.

Although the number of elementary school children presently attending the Fr. Marc school is down from the years before its current political and humanitarian crisis, the number of students attending secondary school has risen. Currently there are 115 elementary students and 84 secondary students. The elementary school has a teaching staff of ten, with two administrators. There is a team of six support staff, who undertake cleaning and meal preparation duties.

Kindergarten begins at age three, and there are 40 children spread across its three years with 13 of them newly registered this school year. All Kindergarten students reached the performance expectations for their age/grade level. Grades one through six have 75 students of which 67 were successful on their first quarter exams. We do not have comparable academic information available on the students who are attending secondary school in Fond des Blancs, but we hope to make that information available to you soon.

Finally, the Board of Directors of IC Haiti is happy to share the good news that a Haitian-born American nursing student has graciously volunteered to serve as our translator in direct communications with both the elementary and secondary school administrators in Haiti. In addition we will continue to work with and through our long-time partner Health Equity International (formerly known as St. Boniface Haiti Foundation) which runs the hospital in Fond des Blancs.

The second collection for IC Haiti will take place on March 23.


