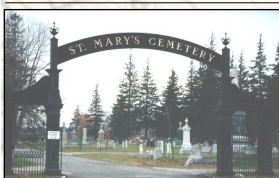

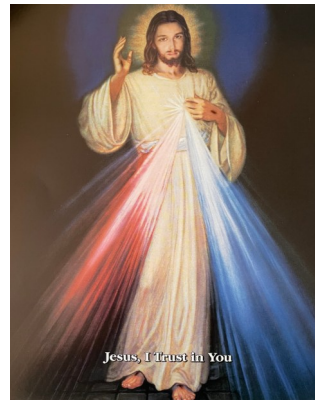

Divine Mercy Devotion



Throughout Lent, we have been going through the acronym "F.I.N.C.H." to explain the key components of the Divine Mercy devotion. This week, we get to "N": **Novena**. The Divine Mercy novena, like all novenas, is a nine-day period of prayer, taking to heart Jesus' admonition to persist in our petitions before God (cf. Luke 11:5–13 and 18:1–8). While the Divine Mercy Novena can be prayed any time of the year, it is most fitting and encouraged from Good Friday

through the day before Divine Mercy Sunday (novenas are typically prayed on the nine days *leading up to* a feast). This novena has us each day bringing people to the Font of Mercy, Jesus' Sacred Heart: all sinners, priests and religious, devout souls, unbelievers, those separated from the Church, children, souls in purgatory, those devoted to mercy, the lukewarm, etc. so that Jesus might pour out His mercy upon them. This is a great prayer for those who are sick, dying, or have recently died, but it is truly good for any manner of petition as we mercifully consider and pray for all of God's people, especially those most in need of His Mercy!

Who was St. Francis?

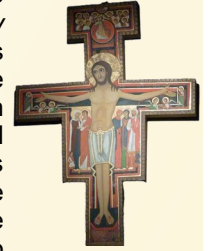
Giovanni de Bernadone, later known as St. Francis of Assisi, lived a life of continual conversion. During this year's **Franciscan Jubilee**, Pope Leo has called the faithful to imitate St. Francis' example through our daily living of the Gospel and its teachings.

The son of a wealthy merchant family, his youth was focused on living extravagantly as he aspired to knighthood. He was injured in battle and endured imprisonment and serious illness. Once returned to his family, he began to hear the call of God. Renouncing his family and his inheritance, he detached himself from earthly things to follow Jesus. He lived humbly, serving the poor and the infirmed. He committed himself to the care of God's creation and its creatures expressed in his



first writing, *Canticle of the Creatures*.

While at prayer in St. Damiano Church, the crucified Christ charged him to "*repair my church which is falling into ruin*". St. Francis repaired the physical structure as he spiritually renewed countless souls through his itinerant ministry. He founded a papal approved community of friars, and, with his good friend and spiritual companion, Clare founded the Poor Clares, a contemplative order of Franciscan nuns dedicated to prayer, penance, and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Francis bore the stigmata in his hands and side and spent his life in constant prayer and reconciliation, ministering to the marginalized and inhabiting life as an instrument of brotherhood and peace.



Throughout the Jubilee year several activities in the Collaborative will focus on St. Francis' life and teachings as we become better acquainted with the man and his impact. Many opportunities exist within HRIC parishes to imitate Francis' good works: supporting the Soup and Sandwich program, donating care packs for our unhoused brothers and sisters, reconciliation, supporting St. Vincent de Paul, volunteering with our many ministries, and enhancing prayer life with daily Mass and Stations of the Cross. "*All the darkness in the world cannot extinguish the light of a singular candle.*"

IC Haiti



IC Haiti will take up its first Quarterly collection for 2026 the weekend of **March 21–22**. There has been constant turmoil in Haiti since the assassination of its president back in 2021. Still the Father Mark Piché Elementary School in Puit Chacha,

Haiti, the secondary schools in nearby Fond des Blancs attended by our elementary school's graduates, and the St. Boniface Hospital in Fond des Blancs have all been fully functional throughout this crippling social, political, and economic crisis. These institutions have continued to operate because of the heroic service of the native Haitians who staff the schools and hospitals and because of the faithful support of parishioners like you. We at HRIC are the sole financial supporters of the Fr. Mark Piché Elementary School and the sole providers of tuition fees for graduates who continue their education in the secondary schools in Fond des Blanc. We also make contributions to Health Equity International to support the health services provided by St. Boniface Hospital.

The call to serve our brothers and sisters in Haiti is a blessing for our Collaborative parishes. Since IC Haiti's inception in 2009, we have offered alms to meet the educational, nutritional, and health needs of the poor in one small area of Haiti. In addition, we have offered relief and recovery support when natural disasters, such as earthquakes, hurricanes, and pandemics have taken place. All this was made possible through your steadfast generosity at the times of the quarterly collections and when an emergency response was called for.

Again, **IC Haiti will take up its first Quarterly collection for 2026 the weekend of March 21–22**. Donations can be made through the second collections at all HRIC Masses that weekend. Please use either your preprinted envelopes or the yellow envelopes found in the pews. **If your contribution is by check, be sure to make out your check to "IC Haiti."**

Guidelines for Lent

Fasting, almsgiving, and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent.

Fasting during Lent

Good Friday is a day of fasting. Catholics age 18–59 are bound to the obligation of fasting. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including water, milk, and fruit juices are allowed.

Abstinence during Lent

Abstinence is observed on **all Fridays** of Lent. Abstinence is the absence of meat all day. Fish is allowed during Lent, though. All Catholics over 14 years of age are bound to the obligation of abstinence.

Travel-sized or slightly larger items work best as they are easily carried in a backpack. There are marked collection bins in each church and the IC Parish Center lobby. We will collect care packs throughout Lent. God bless you for your generosity.

A Lenten Directed Retreat

As his death on the cross approached, Jesus prayed “Father, forgive them, they know not what they do.” (Lk.23:34) In his final moments, experiencing profound physical, mental, and spiritual suffering Jesus prayed not for himself, but for others. His total self-emptying and perfect love moved him to forgive those who crucified him. Throughout his life Jesus’ words and works affirmed a forgiving spirit was essential to follow him.

This retreat will explore the process, power, and fruits of forgiveness through sacramental confession, scripture, spiritual writers, prayer, reflection, and spiritual direction. The Sacrament of Reconciliation through which we receive forgiveness for our own sins and the grace to become more like Christ is central to our Lenten practice and important to this retreat.

Four one-hour spiritual direction sessions scheduled at your convenience. This offering is designed to provide an affordable, convenient retreat that creates an intimate space for you to share yourself deeply with the Holy Spirit’s guidance.
