## Collaborative Pastoral Council

### Meeting Minutes: Sat., January 11, 2025 – 9 a.m., Zoom

**General Updates:** Fr. George and Fr. Stanley are out of the office for the first few weeks of the year. Any Mass adjustments will be in bulletin or on the website.

The Christmas play on Christmas Eve put on by the grade school CCD students was well attended and there were no issues with parking.

**Call to Service:** Finding enough Eucharistic ministers, lectors, and ushers is a challenge, especially at HR. Active participants in these ministries are encouraged to recruit new participants, particularly HS students. Please contact Melinda in the offices to become a participant.

**Door-to-Door Evangelization:** Aaron proposed training a team that would go door to door to bring the light of the Gospel. Aaron will recruit a team, train, and run a pilot program.

**RIM (Refugee Immigrant Ministry) Program:** HRIC has been invited to participate in a new cluster group that will be centered in Newburyport. This regional program aims to cooperatively support individuals or families who are legal asylum seekers until they have paperwork completed to work. The program will be vetted and evaluated by the Collaborative over the next few months.

**CSN Paper Drive and Care Pack Programs:** Collection of paper and cleaning products for the Community Service of Newburyport continues through the end of January. Collection of care pack items will be conducted during Lent. This collection of care pack contents meets the need for a couple of months after Lent, but the need is constant and growing. A parallel program where care packs are purchased at different times during the year is in its infancy and hopefully the Collaborative will be a leader in implementing this important program. **Thank you for your continuing generosity.**

**Safety Committee:** A new safety committee will be formed to address safety concerns while at Mass. The Ministry committee will recruit, train, and run the program initially.

## Guidelines for Lent

Fasting, almsgiving, and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent.

### Fasting during Lent

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting. Catholics age 18–59 are bound to the obligation of fasting. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including water, milk, and fruit juices are allowed.

### Abstinence during Lent

Abstinence is observed on *all* Fridays of Lent. Abstinence is the absence of meat all day. Fish is allowed during Lent, though. All Catholics over 14 years of age are bound to the obligation of abstinence.

# LENT IN THE COLLABORATIVE

## Lenten 5-Week Rosary Challenge

### Introduction

During Lent this year, we want to challenge everyone to pray the rosary. Many great popes, saints, and Christian leaders have encouraged us to pray the rosary. It's a powerful prayer that can change your life, strengthen the family, bring peace to the world, convert entire nations, and win the salvation of souls.

We would like to do an in-depth look at the Sorrowful Mysteries. Each week we'll provide a short meditation and some references that you can research, if you choose, during the week as part of your Lenten meditations.

Here is a guide on How to Say the Rosary for those who are unfamiliar or would like a refresher.

### Praying the Rosary

1. Make the Sign of the Cross.
2. Holding the Crucifix, say the *Apostles' Creed*.
3. On the first bead, say an *Our Father*.
4. Say one *Hail Mary* on each of the next three beads.
5. Say the *Glory Be*.
6. For each of the five decades, announce the Mystery (perhaps followed by a brief reading from Scripture) then say the *Our Father*.
7. While fingering each of the ten beads of the decade, next say ten *Hail Marys* while meditating on the Mystery. Then say a *Glory Be*. (After finishing each decade, some say the following prayer requested by the Blessed Virgin Mary at Fatima: *O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell; lead all souls to Heaven, especially those who have most need of your mercy.*)

After saying the five decades, say the *Hail, Holy Queen*, followed by this dialogue and prayer: **V.** Pray for us, O holy Mother of God. **R.** That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ. *Let us pray: O God, whose Only Begotten Son, by his life, Death, and Resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant, we beseech thee, that while meditating on these mysteries of the most holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.*

### Directed Lenten Retreat






