

## From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

In the third release of the Indiana Jones movies, *Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade*, there is a wonderful scene near the end of the film that has our hero, Indiana Jones, who is desperate to save his dying father, willing to enter a danger-riddled passageway to retrieve the Holy Grail—the actual cup used by Christ at the Last Supper—which will give eternal life to whomever drinks from it. In his father's book of ancient research notes, he reads that "only the penitent man" may pass through the entranceway, known as the "Breath of God." Several decapitated bodies remind him of divine judgment and what awaits him if he is not found to be "penitent." At the last second, he recalls that the "penitent man" is humbled before God...and bows down, just as the swinging blades of the booby-trapped corridor whisk only inches above, where a prouder, more self-righteous man would have lost his head. Although it is classic Hollywood drama, the message is clear: humility is required if one wants to live in God's presence.



This weekend's Gospel offers a similar message. Responding to the notion that some people perished in a tragedy due to some fault or sin of their own, Jesus reassures his followers that these victims were no more sinners than anyone else, "But I tell you, if you do not repent, you will all perish as they did!" The need for repentance and a continuous turning back to God is an

essential part of the life of the disciple not only an occasional action. St. Paul will remind us in his Letter to the Romans, "For there is no distinction; all have sinned and are deprived of the glory of God." (3:23) Fortunately, he will also go on to say, "They are justified freely by his grace through the redemption in Christ Jesus." (3:24) It just goes to underscore the need we all have to be about works of penance and to be always seeking ways to better our relationship with God. It is Lent, embodied.

The image of the fig tree, barren of fruit and draining the soil of its nutrients is a sobering reminder that while God is patient, and willing to give every living being its chance to bring forth a harvest for the Kingdom, God's patience is not infinite. There will come a time when we need to respond to all of the nurturing and opportunities we have received. We do need to produce fruit.

I look forward every year to enjoying some fresh figs when they become available in the supermarkets usually in the late summer or early fall. Their delicate flavor and sweetness are a joy to behold. God looks for this same joy in us when we more completely conform our lives to His Will, when we are more about His works, than off, "doing our own thing." The prophet Hosea reminds us, "for it is loyalty that I desire, not sacrifice, and knowledge of God rather than burnt offerings." (Hosea 6:6) Becoming closer to God, being penitent, means a willingness to reorder our lives in such a way that God's love becomes our first priority, lived-out in all of our relationships and brought to bear in all of the encounters we experience day-in and day-out.

May our Lenten penance bear much fruit in our lives and for God's Kingdom this week.



### Lenten 5-Week Rosary Challenge

**The Third Sorrowful Mystery: The Crowning of Thorns**

**Spiritual Fruit:** Reign of Christ in our hearts

Jesus is taken into the Praetorium and clothed in an old purple cloak. The soldiers weave a crown of thorns and placing it on His head, they force the thorns deep into His scalp. The soldiers bow and spit upon Him in mockery of His claimed Kingship. Jesus is tortured horrendously and then taken to Pilate for final judgement. Pilate, noticing that the crowds are still not appeased by the pitiful sight before them, allows for Jesus to be turned over to death, and the murderous Barabbas to be released in His place. This mystery teaches us of the unspeakable humiliation Christ endured for reparation of our sins. Through Christ's humiliation, He upholds the dignity of all those who are demeaned by violence (Rosary.com)

## Centering Prayer for Lent

Centering Prayer is an ancient Christian practice available to all who seek transformation through a more intimate relationship with God.

Consider joining us and let God move you closer to him. We gather Wednesdays from 6:00–7:00 p.m. via Zoom. Following 30 minutes of Centering Prayer, we practice Lectio Divina. We listen to God's words in scripture, ponder, and share what we hear the Lord saying to us here and now.




