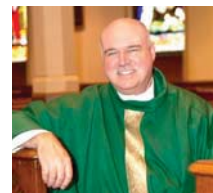
Second Collection May 18-19

From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

This past weekend, we celebrated two of what will be five First Communion Masses within our Collaborative. I want to share with you how much joy I had in my heart to welcome these young people and their families to our Eucharist! It is a moment ripe with opportunity and possibility. I remember my own First Communion moment from more than 50 years ago. An ancient Fr. Kelly (who was probably my age at the time!) held up the Host and said, "The Body of Christ," to which I promptly forgot my one line, "Amen." I just stood there, saying nothing, frozen in horror that I had forgotten what to say. Somebody (probably my mom) finally prompted me with the proper response, and I somehow made it through this harrowing experience, never to forget my line again. It was my first of what are probably by now many tens of thousands of times that I have received Holy Communion.

It is my sincere hope that the young people who are coming to our church in these final weeks of our Easter season will not only remember this special, sacred moment of their first encounter with the Body and Blood of the Lord, but that they will find strength, joy, and comfort from receiving this precious gift over and over again throughout their lives.

Everyone who comes to our church is on a unique faith journey—some are weekly attendees with their names practically etched in a particular pew and some are discerning where God may be calling them to be in their faith practice. Some may be here because they couldn't imagine being anywhere else on Sunday morning, others were literally dragged into church, kicking and screaming (as I once was as a toddler, occupying the glassed-in "crying room" at our local parish more than once...). Some come out of curiosity. Some are attracted to the beautiful, live music. Others come for the nostalgia of "smells and bells," stained-glass, and the trappings of religion from long ago. Some come with an open, wondering heart to ponder life's deepest questions. Still others come to grieve and mourn the loss of a loved one, of mistakes made and relationships lost. Some come seeking forgiveness and mercy from a God they wish they knew better. Some come to give thanks for the many blessings they have received. And sometimes they just come—out of habit, not really considering the why of it all. Some come intentionally. Some come by accident or obligation. Some show up for someone else. Some come, for themselves, for their own interior reasons. All come as equals before a loving and

May Collection for IC Haiti

Hope Rising: IC Haiti.

The second collection for the weekend of **May 25–26** supports IC Haiti's continuing mission to the school community in Puit Chacha, Haiti. We have been able to fund the annual school budgets there thanks to the generosity of parishioners and former parishioners from both Holy Redeemer and Immaculate Conception. Despite Haiti's present chaotic condition, the Father Marc Piché Elementary school has been functioning daily. The attendance there and at the secondary school in Fond des Blancs where we tuition in the older students has been exemplary. The commitment and perseverance of teachers and staff in both places have been heroic.

Since we funded the budget for the 2023–24 school year last fall, our collections now are in preparation to fund the 2024–25 school year. Last October we fully funded the budget for \$70,150. We do not yet know what the projected costs for the 2024–25 school year will be, but we do know that costs for food, fuel, and all sorts of materials have risen between 30 and 50%.

In anticipation of a dramatic increase in costs to fund the budget for the 2024–25 school year, the Board of Directors for IC Haiti once again appeals to the generosity of parishioners. Please continue to support our Haitian brothers and sisters in Christ with your prayers and monetary contributions. As a Collaborative, we have been blessed by God for the past fifteen years to carry on this invaluable mission to Haiti. We are reminded of this spiritual reality by the familiar words of St. Francis of Assisi: *"Lord, make us instruments of Your peace...it is in giving that we receive."*
