ARCHBISHOP RICHARD G. HENNING STATEMENT ON THE ELECTION OF POPE LEO XIV

With great joy we received the news from Rome: *habemus papam!* We have a pope! I join with Catholics in the Archdiocese of Boston and throughout the world, along with people of good will, in celebrating the election of Pope Leo XIV as the new Holy Father. We pray for him as he begins this ministry as the Vicar of Christ and the Bishop of Rome. May he be for us a visible source and foundation of communion in faith. In his first words to us, Pope Leo spoke of the peace that is the gift of the Lord Jesus:

Peace be with you all, this is the first greeting of the resurrected Christ, the good shepherd who has given up his life for God. And I should also like this greeting of peace to enter our hearts and our families. (Pope Leo XIV from the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica)

May that peace give him strength and consolation, and may it fill our hearts as we live our own calling.

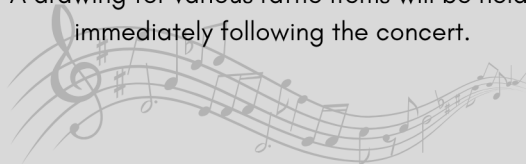

We were pleased to welcome Most Reverend Robert F. Hennessey to Holy Redeemer Parish, Nativity Church on May 10. The Gifts of the Holy Spirit were conferred upon ten young men and women. Bishop Hennessey always makes this a very special celebration for those being confirmed as well as for their families and friends. May these newly confirmed be assured of our continued prayers as they take the next step in their journey of faith.

IC Haiti Updates

The second of IC Haiti's four annual collections will be taken up **the weekend of May 24–25** at all HRIC Collaborative Masses. We are currently keeping up with the rising inflationary costs brought on by the ongoing societal upheaval in Haiti. Still, we ask for your continued generosity to help educate, feed, and provide dental and medical care for the school children of Puit Chacha, Haiti. Gang violence still reigns in many areas, but it has not reached Puit Chacha* and Fond des Blancs** directly. Still, the ramifications of this societal crisis are felt throughout Haiti.

*The Father Marc Piché elementary school is in Puit Chacha.

**Saint Boniface Hospital is in Fond des Blancs. Our elementary school graduates attend secondary schools there.

Earlier this month we received some distressing news from our partners in Haiti: Health Equity International (formerly known as the Saint Boniface Haiti Foundation). HEI's president, Conor Shapiro (who spoke at IC Masses prior to the Covid outbreak in 2020) informed us that:

The U.S. Government has terminated its five-year USAID contract to strengthen Haiti's health system, including St. Boniface Hospital. The sudden and shocking loss of funding has immediate and dangerous repercussions for our patients and for St. Boniface Hospital—one of the few functional hospitals remaining in Haiti as the ongoing humanitarian crisis pushes the entire healthcare system toward collapse.

The USAID funding St. Boniface Hospital received ...helped us meet the unprecedented demand for maternal and child health care, HIV/AIDS testing and treatment services, comprehensive community health services, and more. It was also critical to helping us manage the skyrocketing costs of procuring and transporting the essential medicines and supplies we need to care for hundreds of patients every single day. While we have many sources of funding, USAID was able to provide a significant multi-year investment that was instrumental in helping us keep up with rapid inflation and go to any lengths necessary to stay fully operational during this catastrophic period in Haiti.

For those who would like to process to the garden from the church, turn left from the parking lot onto Washington Street. Cross over Route 1, cross over Winter Street (look for the Cookie Jar on your right) and turn left at the Washington Street Trailhead.

The garden is located between Mile Markers 02 and 03 on the left side of the trail after crossing over Low St.

It is an approximately 20 minute walk from the church to the entrance to the trailhead.

For those who would prefer to drive, there is an entrance at the Parker Street Trailhead. Parking is available in the Seacoast Business Park at 65 Parker Street. Use the crosswalk to enter the rail trail. It is an approximate five minute walk from the entrance at the trail head. The garden is located on the right between Mile Markers 02 and 03.

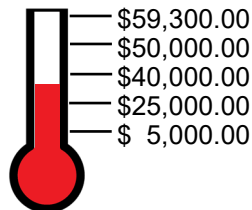

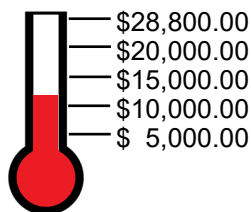
