## From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Below, please find the text of a press release from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops and its president, Archbishop Timothy Broglio. This was sent from the Archdiocese this past week, but too late to be included in last week's bulletin.

### United States Conference of Catholic Bishops

June 16, 2025

 **Office of Public Affairs** **WASHINGTON** — “As your shepherds, your fear echoes in our hearts and we make your pain our own. Count on the commitment of all of us to stand with you in this challenging hour,” said Archbishop Timothy P. Broglio, president of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), addressing the surge in immigration enforcement actions. He offered a reflection on behalf of the bishops of the United States and acknowledged that while law enforcement actions to preserve order and ensure community security are necessary for the common good, we cannot turn a deaf ear to the anxiety and fear in communities. Archbishop Broglio’s reflection follows:

*Just before the opening of the special assembly of the US Conference of Catholic Bishops, it seems appropriate to give voice to a profound concern in the hearts of the Shepherds of the Church in our Country.*

*When he spoke to the young people of Chicago this past weekend, Pope Leo XIV reminded us that at the heart of the Christian faith is an invitation to share in the communion of life and love of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, the first community and based completely on love. The Holy Father also challenged us to be a sign of hope by making the world a better place.*

*Considering Pope Leo’s message, no one can turn a deaf ear to the palpable cries of anxiety and fear heard in communities throughout the country in the wake of a surge in immigration enforcement actions.*

*Law enforcement actions aimed at preserving order and ensuring community security are necessary for the common good. However, the current efforts go well beyond those with criminal histories. In the context of a gravely deficient immigration system, the mass arrest and removal of our neighbors, friends and family members on the basis of immigration status alone, particularly in ways that are arbitrary or without due process, represent a profound social crisis before which no person of good will can remain silent. The situation is far from the communion of life and love to which this nation of immigrants should strive.*

*The many actions of protest throughout the country reflect the moral sentiments of many Americans that enforcement alone cannot be the solution to addressing our nation’s immigration challenges.*

While protest and dissent can be a legitimate expression of democratic participation, violence is never acceptable. At the same time, it is good to remember Pope Francis' admonition that "without equal opportunities the different forms of aggression and conflict will find a fertile terrain for growth and eventually explode" (*Evangelii gaudium*, 59).

The chronic lack of opportunities for legal status for our immigrant brothers and sisters, together with the growing denial of due process to them, is injurious to human dignity and is a considerable factor in the breakdown of the rule of law. Likewise, unfounded accusations against Catholic service providers, who every day endeavor to provide critical support and care to the most vulnerable, contribute to societal tensions and a growing climate of fear.

On behalf of my brother bishops, I want to assure all of those affected by actions which tear at the fabric of our communities of the solidarity of your pastors. As your shepherds, your fear echoes in our hearts and we make your pain our own. Count on the commitment of all of us to stand with you in this challenging hour.

I acknowledge those in our Catholic service and community organizations working to promote the common good by binding up the wounds of the afflicted. Let those motivated by the urgency of the current moment to work for just and humane solutions to these immigration challenges know of the cooperation and goodwill of the Catholic Bishops of our country.

For joy, for friends, for something true.


Now from the altar he steps down,

## Brief Personal Biography of Kennedy Ogujiuba

Beloved Parishioners of Holy Redeemer - Immaculate Conception Collaborative,

Grace and peace to you all in Christ Jesus!



My journey to the seminary did not begin with a dramatic moment, but with something quieter—a whisper. It was gentle, persistent, and full of mystery. As a young boy growing up in Nigeria, I was deeply moved by the joyful and faithful presence of the priests who served in our parish. Their quiet strength and dedication to God and His people planted a seed in me.

Like many seeds, however, it needed time, light, and care to grow. I pursued my education and sought God's will through many paths. Yet that quiet whisper never left me. It matured into a longing, a longing to give my life completely to Christ, to walk with His people, and to serve as His priest. Responding to that call, I entered formation at the seminary in Nigeria where I spent a reasonable number of years until 2017. Today I am blessed to be back on a beautiful path of priestly formation for the Archdiocese of Boston, studying at St. John's Seminary in Brighton. I recently completed my first year at the seminary, and this summer assignment is a cherished step in my journey toward priesthood and parish life in the United States.

Since arriving at Holy Redeemer - Immaculate Conception Collaborative, Newburyport, I have already experienced the warmth and kindness of your pastor, Fr. Timothy Harrison, the priests in residence, and from you all. I say a heartfelt thank you for your welcome. It is a gift to be here with you this summer.

Allow me to share a little more about myself. My name is Kennedy Ogujiuba, and I come originally from the East part Nigeria, where I spent most of my life before moving to the United States in 2023. I come from a big and loving family of ten—my parents, five sisters, two brothers, and myself. Family and faith were the foundations of my early formation, and they continue to guide my vocation today. My parents' witness, along with the vibrant life of our

parish, gave me the strength to embrace God's call with joy and trust, even through moments of challenge and uncertainty.

- **2000–2003:** Junior Secondary – Assumpta Minor Seminary, Nigeria

- **2008:** Began formation with the Claretian Missionaries
- **2009–2010:** Novitiate – Claretian Missionary Congregation, Nigeria
- **2010–2014:** B.A. and B. Phil – Claretian Institute of Philosophy, Nigeria
- **2014–2015:** Pastoral Year in Nigeria
- **2015–2017:** Theology – Spiritan International School of Theology, Nigeria
- **2023–2024:** Master's in Theological Studies – Providence College, Rhode Island
- **2024–Present:** Ongoing priestly formation – St. John's Seminary, Boston

### Where am I now?

I am currently serving in my summer pastoral assignment here at Holy Redeemer - Immaculate Conception Collaborative in Newburyport. What a great and vibrant place to begin a summer pastoral assignment!

As I begin my work with you, I do so with a heart full of hope and openness. I am eager to serve wherever I am needed, whether in the liturgy, with the youth and elderly, in parish ministries, or simply by being present and listening. Even more, I have come to know and learn from you. Your witness, your stories, and your faith will shape me as I continue this journey. I believe a parish is truly a school for pastoral and spiritual formation, and I am honored to walk with you on this journey.






