Please note: We are suspending the delivery of soups until the fall. Casseroles are still welcome!

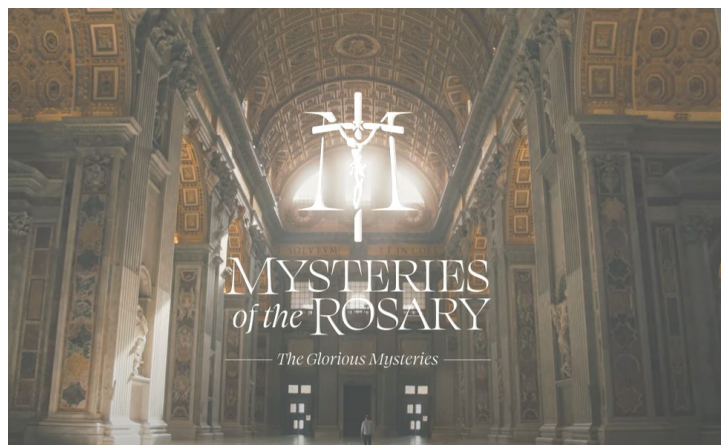
