CHRISTIE'S CAROUSEL OF LEARNING FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1) What ages must the children be to attend school?

They must be 2-9 years of age for the Summer and 2-5 years of age for the Fall Programs.

2) Do the children need to be potty trained?

No. Contact us for details about our potty-training program.

3) Do the children need to attend the same days each week in the summer and fall school year?

No, in the summer your days and times may vary each week or remain the same.

Yes, in the fall school year, they must stay consistent with the 2, 3, 4, or 5 days you choose when registering. All times must be the same for all the days registered.

4) When can I come visit your school?

We have a virtual tour on our website. For in person tours please call 847-825-4568 to schedule.

5) Do you have availability now?

All availability is offered on a first come, first serve basis. Please call Jan, Judy, or Nancy at 847-825-4568 or email at info@christiescarousel.com to find the exact days and times that are available.

6) How do I register for the upcoming Summer Program and/or Fall Program?

You may register for the Summer and Fall Programs at the same time or Summer only or Fall only at our Open registration. Our procedure for registration is as follows:

- A) The families currently enrolled register first.
- B) We then open registration to the public on a first come, first serve basis according to availability.

Enclosed are details on how to register your child for our Summer and/or Fall Programs.

7). What do you teach the children on a daily basis?

Our curriculum goals and daily schedule are enclosed.

8). What are the class sizes?

The teacher/child ratio according to DCFS are: one teacher with eight two-year-olds, one teacher with ten three/four/five/six-year-olds and one teacher with fifteen children enrolled in kindergarten or primary grades.

9). Are you Licensed?

Yes, we are licensed by the Department of Children and Family Services and must follow the state guidelines which are kept on file at our school. Also refer to the Summary of Licensing Standards For Day Care Centers available at the school.

2024 Summer Camp Registration Information and Procedure

- Summer Camp ages 2-9 years old
- The Summer Program is from June 10, 2024-August 9, 2024. You may choose any or all 9 weeks. The days and times for each week may be the same or different.
- You may choose specific weeks or all 9 weeks to send your child/children.
- You may choose the same or different days each week.
- You may choose the same or different times each week. The times each week must be the same time for the entire week.
- Once you have registered your child for any specific week, you may not drop any days, times or weeks nor can you substitute any one week or one day for another.
- You may add additional weeks to your child's schedule if space is available.

Summer Payment Information

- The summer weekly rates are below.
- The summer fees will be collected as follows
- Sibling discount is 10% per child for the same or lesser schedule.
- If you enroll your child/children in programs 2 (7:30-12:30), 3 (9:00-12:30), 4 (9:00-11:30), your child/children's full tuition of all weeks enrolled is due June 1, 2024.
- If you enroll your child/children in programs 1 (7:30-5:30) and they are enrolled for any 4 weeks or less, your child/children's tuition payment for all weeks enrolled is due on June 1, 2024.
- If you enroll your child/children in programs 1 (7:30-5:30) and they are enrolled for any 5 weeks or more, your child/children's tuition payment will be charged accordingly: weeks 1-5 are due on June 1, 2024 and weeks 6-9 are due on July 1, 2024.
- Fees are subject to change in accordance with rising costs. A non-refundable registration fee of \$75.00 will be due upon confirmation. Expenses incurred in operating the school are based on anticipated income. All tuition paid is nonrefundable. There are no adjustments or credits for absenteeism's, illnesses, vacations, school closings, holidays, Covid 19 quarantine or classroom closures and withdrawal from Christie's Carousel of Learning Programs.

Christie's Carousel of Learning Program Curriculum

Children are placed in classrooms according to their age as of September 1st. Teachers observe through daily assessments. If a child has met the goals listed for their age, they will be challenged and provided with additional developmentally appropriate activities.

2/3 Year Olds:

Language:

- -Recognizes and identifies common objects and pictures
- -Uses pronouns

Cognitive:

- -Sorts five objects by color
- -Plays make-believe with dolls, stuffed animals and people

Social/Emotional:

- -Expresses a wide range of emotion
- -Separates easily from parents

Large Motor:

- -Walks up stairs with support, alternating feet
- -Pedals a bike/tricycle

Small Motor:

- -Builds a tower of more than six blocks
- -Makes vertical, horizontal, and circular strokes with a pencil, crayon or brush

3/4 Year Olds:

Language:

- -Understands the concepts of, "same," and, "different."
- -Asks questions with, "What," "Who," "Where," and "Why."

Cognitive:

- -Follows three-part commands
- -Recalls parts of a story

Social/Emotional:

- -Cooperates/plays with other children
- -More independent/dresses and undresses self

Large Motor:

- -Hops and stands on one foot up to five seconds
- -Kicks ball forward and throws ball overhand

Small Motor:

- -Draws a person with 2-4 body parts
- -Draws circles and squares and uses scissors

4/5 Year Olds: Pre-K

Language:

- -Says full name and knows address and phone number
- -Uses future tense and tells longer stories

Cognitive:

- -Can count ten or more objects
- -Better understand the concept of time

Social/Emotional:

- -Shows more independence
- -Likes to sing, dance, and act

Large Motor:

- -Hops, somersaults, swings and climbs
- -Stand on one foot for ten seconds or longer

Small Motor:

- -Prints letters in their name, along with others
- -Copies triangle and other geometric patterns

Pre-K assessments are completed for each child twice a year.

Pre-K parent/teachers conferences are held in the spring.

These are examples of the goals that we set for each age group.

Fall 2024-2025 Registration Information and Procedure

- Fall school year ages 2-5 years old
- The Fall 2024-2025 Program is from August 12, 2024 June 6, 2025.
- You may choose 2, 3, 4 or 5 days a week.
- You may choose 7:30-5:30 or 7:30-12:30 or 9:00-12:30 or 9:00-11:30.
- The days and times you choose must remain the same throughout the school year unless you request for additions if available.
- Once you have registered your child for their specific days and times and they are confirmed, you may not drop any days and times or your child's spot will be relinquished.
- There are no substitutions or swapping of days

Fall 2024-2025 Payment Information
