



The club is teaming up with the Angling Trust again in December to clear our riverbanks of unsightly rubbish. This will be our third year working in support of 'Anglers Against Litter', a campaign that began in 2020 and has now been taken up by over 200 clubs across the UK.

We plan to meet at Hillier Garden Centre Car Park at 9.00am on Saturday December 6<sup>th</sup>. The clean-up will include the North Bank and Stepping Stones and will run till around 1pm. All volunteers will be provided with hi-vis vests, litter pickers and bin bags, but please bring suitable footwear, gloves and refreshments.

ReAP, a company dedicated to recycling plastic from aquatic ecosystems, will be collecting all plastic waste after the event to ensure it doesn't go to landfill. The club has also arranged for Mole Valley District Council to collect all non-recyclable rubbish.
