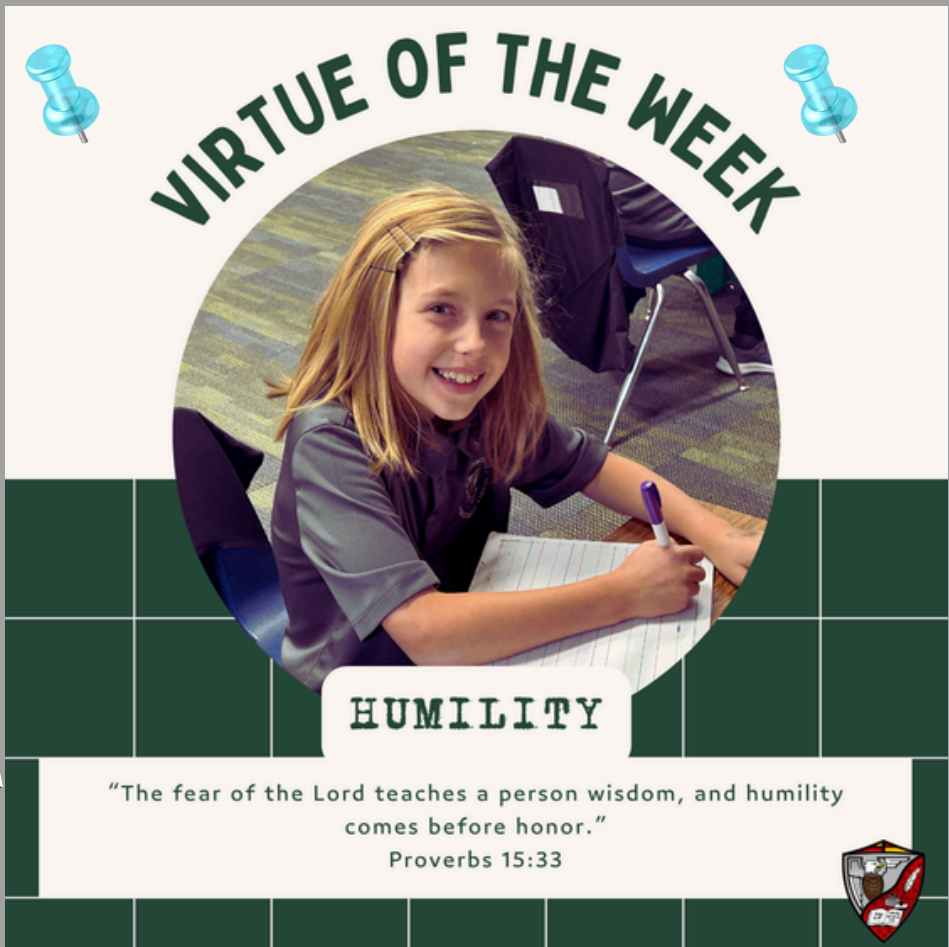

NDFU has the largest camping program in North Dakota for both rural and urban youth. Camps are held at Jamestown and Heart Butte (near Elgin) in June, July and August. Transportation is provided to and from camp at predetermined locations. Cost includes meals, lodging, t-shirt, educational materials and entertainment. **Register by May 15** to get a discount on registration fee. Financial scholarships are available for youth needing assistance. Campers **earn prizes** for referring friends, and **award trips** for youth program participation.

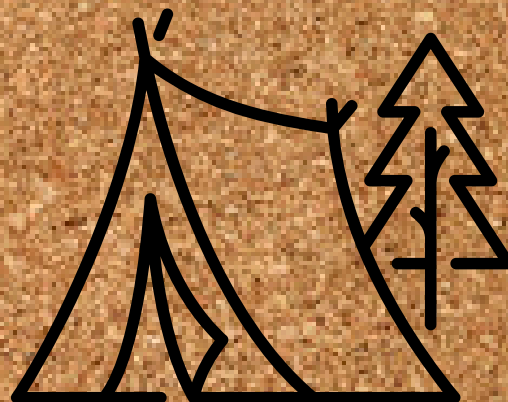


Carly Rott, EPIC Coach, and Cole Just, NDFU youth, promoting camp after receiving grant money for guardian helmets.
