The K-12 Art Show is designed with uplifting young creatives in the Jamestown area in mind. *This show is not Juried*, JFAA would like to see student work in it's most expressive and authentic form.

Although there is no fee for entry, all work completed on paper (such as drawings or photos) will need to be framed or matted. This year, to help with preparation costs, JFAA is offering to provide matting services.

Students enrolled in the k-12 public schools will have a designated drop off in their school for convenience. All other participants will need to bring their work to the Art Center directly.

All work must be clearly labeled on the back/bottom of the artwork using the tag provided.
ALL packing material must have Artist's name on it.

The Arts Center staff reserves the right to reject any entry that does not meet eligibility requirements and the artwork will not be displayed.

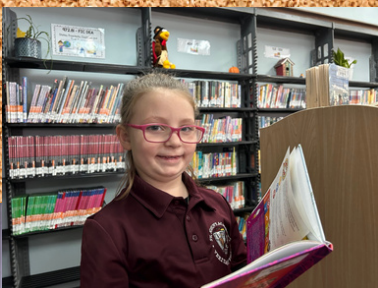

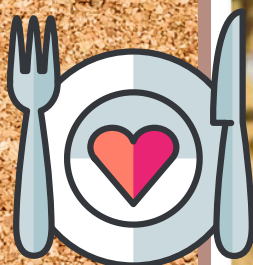
