TEMPERENCE

Temperance, represented by an olive wreath, is the cardinal virtue that crowns our decisions and joys with a holy balance and right discipline. What exactly does that mean?

Temperance is the virtue that moderates our desire for pleasures and provides balance in the use of created things. The temperate person will keep in mind what is good and maintains healthy decisions. The phrase "everything in moderation" is a good way to remember to have temperance.
