COURTESY

To be courteous means to be polite and to treat others with respect. Showing courtesy throughout your day might look like holding the door open for someone, helping them pick up something they've dropped, making eye contact, or letting others speak first. What other ways can you think of to show courtesy?

In the Bible passage below, Jesus talks of courtesy when you take a seat at a banquet table. Part of being courteous is showing humility while being courteous to those around you. Courtesy is also the absence of pride. You should not be courteous to show how great you are. Show courtesy as a way of serving others. Discuss a time when someone showed courtesy to you.
