MODESTY

Modesty, also known as propriety, is known as having purity of heart in action, especially in regards to dress and speech. Having modesty usually means dressing in privacy and in an appropriate manner, not bragging about talents or achievements, not being eager to talk about yourself, and not trying to be the center of attention in word or action, etc.

Talk with your friends or family about how to be modest and give examples of how to show modesty. Why is modesty important? What can be the consequences be if a person is not modest in their words and actions?

Read the 1 Peter verse (below) and talk about how this connects with where we get our identity.
