

OHIO ASPHALT PAVING CONFERENCE

On behalf of the planning committee of the Ohio Asphalt Paving Conference (OAPC), I would like to invite your company to become an exhibitor at our next conference, scheduled for Wednesday, February 4, 2026. It will be held on the campus of The Ohio State University at the Fawcett Center, 2400 Olentangy River Road, Columbus, Ohio. The purpose of the conference is to provide current technical information on the construction of asphalt pavements to federal, state, and local engineers and technicians, as well as to contractors, consulting engineers, materials suppliers, university representatives, and others from throughout Ohio. The OAPC regularly has an attendance of more than 400 people.

The conference is scheduled to start at 8:30 A.M. and end at 3:00 P.M. It includes a number of technical sessions, breaks, and lunch. The exhibit space has a limited number of electrical outlets, which are first come – first serve. Exhibits will need to be free standing as the display spaces consist of a 6 ft. long by 30in. wide draped table. Exhibits may be setup the day before (until 5:00 P.M.) or on the morning of the conference. The fee for exhibits is \$500, which includes registration for two people, breaks, lunch, and attendance at the technical sessions. Additional individuals are welcome, but will need to register and pay the \$90 registration fee (\$120 after January 14, 2026 and at the door).
