

Lands containing a pollinator planting are not eligible for Managed Harvesting. Routine haying is allowed 1 in 5 years but not during the primary nesting season, March 15 to July 15. Refer to the Forage Harvest Management 511, Job Sheet or Implementation Requirements for more information. Producer must obtain FSA approval before implementing activity.

Contract Item 4 Prescribed Grazing (528)

Routine grazing is the controlled harvest of vegetation with animals. Any lands containing pollinator plantings are not eligible for grazing. Producer must obtain FSA approval prior to implementation.
