Symi Island Beauty: A day of color, cliffs & crystal water

If Rhodes is the vibrant heartbeat of the Dodecanese, Symi is its most charming secret ... a small island that feels like a living postcard. From the moment you approach the harbor, Symi captivates with its neoclassical mansions, painted in warm pastel shades that rise amphitheatrically from the sea. The iconic waterfront of Gialos is one of the most photographed scenes in Greece. Elegant, romantic and full of character.

But Symi's beauty isn't only found on land. The island is surrounded by deep blue water and dramatic coastlines, and few places reveal this better than St. George Bay. This bay is famous for its towering cliffs and wild scenery, a powerful contrast to the gentle charm of the town. Here, the sea is incredibly clear and swimming beneath the cliffs feels like stepping into another world: quiet, raw and unforgettable.





After the bay, the journey continues to Symi's harbor, where you can enjoy free time exploring Gialos at your own pace. SYMI & HIDDEN BAYS CRUISE

St. George Bay (Agios Georgios Dysalonas)

The initial view is transcendent: crystal-clear blue water laps at a silent pebbled shore, while a sheer cliff nearly 300m high soars skyward just beyond. This vertical rock face—appearing as if sliced by a titan's hand creates a dramatic natural amphitheater, even casting cool afternoon shadows over the cove. Perched on the cliff's edge is a tiny white chapel of Saint George, a humble guardian of the bay that whispers of the sacred in this wild place. The exclusivity of arriving by private yacht heightens the sense of discovery; amid such cinematic grandeur, one feels the awe of a Greek odyssey unfolding in real time, utterly removed from the everyday.

Agia Marina (Symi)


Agia Marina's tiny chapel island and bright azure waters, as seen from above the sheltered bay. Gliding into Agia Marina by private yacht, you immediately notice the small rocky islet crowned by a whitewashed chapel, standing watch at the bay's entrance. The cove's waters are a luminous palette of turquoise and sapphire, so pristine that your yacht seems to float on light itself. Encircled by gentle hills, the atmosphere here is one of intimate calm and joyful reverence—indeed, this little sanctuary is beloved as a wedding venue for those seeking a blessing in paradise. The only sounds are the soft lapping of water and the distant tinkling of goat bells, punctuating a tranquility that feels almost hallowed. In Agia Marina, time slows to the rhythm of the Aegean. Each moment is an immersive indulgence, from swimming in warm, crystal waters to simply absorbing the cinematic beauty of a chapel and cove that seem made for poets and daydreams.

Nanou Bay

The hidden cove of Nanou Bay, surrounded by high cliffs dotted with cypress trees and deep, clear waters inviting exploration. Tucked behind high cliffs and cypress-studded slopes, Nanou Bay is a hidden paradise that rewards those arriving by private yacht with utter tranquility.

Symi Port (Gialos)

Lindos Cruise: The Most Iconic Escape on the Rhodes Coast





Kalitheia Springs



Ladiko Bay



Faliraki Beach






