31st January – Perseverance – based on Luke 15: 1-7 following Jesus is not always easy - we make mistakes, or fall but we go back and keep on practising

28th February – Love how does this grow – based on Luke 15: 11-32 God's love keeps on even when we turn away from him. God has huge love for us- and this can shine through us.

28th March — Courage — to tollow Jasse — based on Matthew 26:17-29, 36-45 Although Jesus knows what is going to happen he is courageous throughout Holy week,

29th April – Integrity – stand up and be counted – based on Daniel 3:13-25

Making hard decisions. What should we stand up for? God can help us make decisions, even when they are hard.

30th May - Community - a home for all - based on 1 Corinthians 12:12-27
