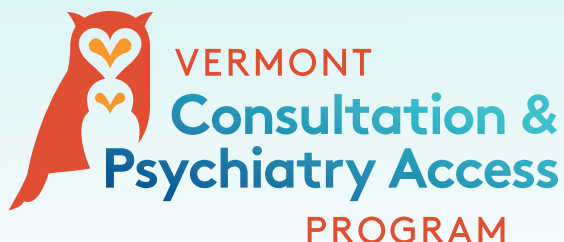


SAFETY PLANNING FOR AUTISTIC YOUTH
