Parenting Bible study! In this study we will reflect on the busy toddler years, challenging teenage years, and everything in between. Whether you're just starting your parenting journey or about to be empty nesters, this course offers insight and encouragement for staying united as you parent together. Don't let the title of the course push you away from attending; we understand that schedules might not allow both parents to attend and that there are single parent households. Everyone is encouraged to come learn from this group regardless of your family structure!

**Phones** - If you have a child that attends Wednesday nights and they bring a cellphone, I encourage you to have a conversation about respectful use while in class and eating supper.

**Dismissal** – If your child is 5th grade or younger, we ask a guardian or an older sibling to come upstairs to get them at dismissal. PreK/K and  $3^{rd}/4^{th}/5^{th}$  dismiss from the top level in the Youth Center.  $1^{st}/2^{nd}$  grade dismisses from the Chapel on the main level. Otherwise, they must wait until their teacher has dismissed everyone else before they can walk them downstairs. This is for their safety and security; and the safety of everyone.

**Food Donations –** Due to the large volume of food needed, we purchase items in bulk to be good stewards of yours and our finances. To cover each week this semester we have a goal of \$3,500.
